# Cat on way to recovery

He's not out of the woods yet, but Shelley and Mark White of Sandy figure they have one tough cat in seven-year-old orange "Sunny."

The tom cat showed up bloody on Christmas, but the couple couldn't catch him to treat his gunshot head wound. The bullet from a rifle (some neighbor, they figure) went through Sunny's jaw and out his neck.

Then 12 days later Sunny

walked home on his own. After three trips to the local vet, Sunny looks like he's cashed in all nine lives and will make it.

"It didn't affect his personality," Mark White said, "but his hearing's gone on one side. It seems it affected his balance."

He doesn't know who tried to shoot his cat's head off, but suspects it was some neighbor to their east Sandy Heights home.

The local vet told them he sees at least one shot cat or dog each week.

"He quit eating for a week," wife Shelley said of the cat with a broken jaw. "We had to put him on IV's."

The couple have had their orange cat since it was a kitten.

"I can't believe they can be that tough and take something like that," Mark White said about cats.
