Developers shopping for second tenant

Mercury Development is still seeking a second "anchor" for its proposed shopping center on the west end of Sandy.

Project coordinator Dave Zimel said this week the company hopes to begin construction this year on the 100,000-square-foot complex, but no ground will be broken until the second major tenant signs an

agreement. That, he said, could be any time.

Zimel did not name the major client who has already agreed to rent.

The project, approved by local officials in late 1979, will include two major retailers and a host of smaller shops. Cost estimate at the time of approval was approximately \$3.5 million.
