Moby Dick a 'natural' for huge wall

It took Roman Scott about four months to complete his mural of Moby Dick in the SUHS library.

"I was kind of surprised when I got done," he said. "I didn't know what I was going to do" with my free time.

"I had always been tired

of that wall, how boring it was," he said. The idea for a mural came before the subject. Moby Dick turned out to be "fairly natural," considering the size of the wall and the size of a whale.

On his own, he submitted a preliminary sketch to the librarian, Jan Luelling, and

to Dennis Crow, vice principal.

Both were enthusiastic about the idea, and so he started to work. Some artists use projectors to throw an image on the wall to use in a preliminary sketch, but not Scott. He just started painting.

"It was a lot of fun. I didn't get tired of it," Scott said. "I just did it every day. It was just part of my life."

Scott is a National Honor Society Member, and plans to major in art in college. He is undecided about where he will attend.

Scott took first in commercial art in state VICA competition, and was honored in 1981 by the National Newspaper Association for the best original cartoon for a weekly newspaper.

Scott said Moby Dick is one of his favorite novels. He said they studied the novel "in depth" in Richard Kennedy's American literature class.

Students raise funds for SUHS crest

Sandy Union High School crest has been painted and placed on the front of the school.

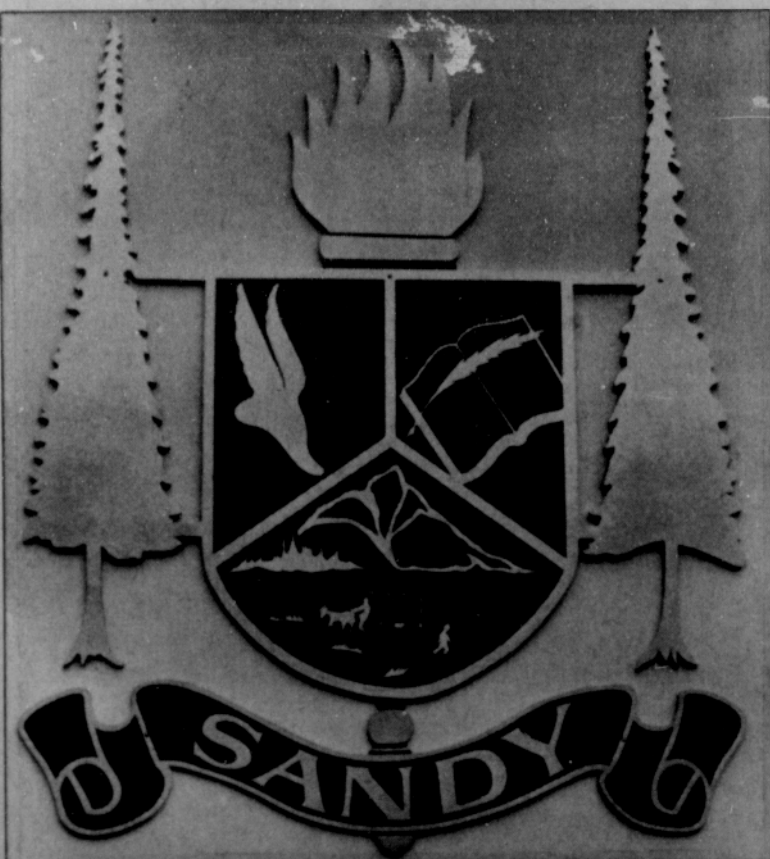
"We feel it represents pride and tradition in the school," said John McMahan, principal. "And, we kind of think it looks nice."

school dances.

A larger emblem, with the trees about 15 feet tall, was made several years ago by a graphics class. It didn't wear well because of the materials used. That emblem was on the west side of the exterior wall of the gymnasium.

'Wellness Is...' Health Care Clinic
...Provides primary health care to adolescents and adults. Examples of care are:

1. Yearly physical exams that include blood pressure monitoring, heart, lung, abdomen, thyroid, and skin assessment. Women's health care which includes PAP smears and breast exams.
2. Assessment and treatment of minor emergencies, lacerations, infections, chronic illness (asthma, diabetes, etc.), minor emotional crisis, and skin lesions.
3. Counseling and guidance for birth control, family planning, pregnancy tests, and crises of daily living.
4. Health education and support groups.
5. Home visits and skilled nursing care for the homebound, elderly, and dying person.
6. Community services that include foot clinics, health forums, resource referral, and formal educational programs.
