

Missionaries discuss work this Sunday

Since 1947, the Rev. Ken Palmer has established four churches and more than 800 believers among two tribes in Ivory Coast, West Africa.

This Sunday, April 10, he will tell about his work at Pleasant Home Baptist Church at 11 a.m.

Palmer, a missionary with the Conservative Baptist Foreign Mission Society of Wheaton, Ill., has worked with his wife Betty among the Dyimini and Dyula tribes of Ivory Coast. Besides the established churches, a dozen other groups meet regularly with monthly visits from one of three local pastors. Churches have experienced tremendous growth, despite competition with Islam and fetishism.

Besides evangelism and church planting, the Palmers steadily visit more than 50 primary schools in their area to distribute literature and contact the teachers. He has translated some scripture into the Dyimini language.

Palmer prepared for missionary service at Northwestern Bible School and Seminary in Minneapolis, Minn., and Hardin Simmons University in Abilene, Texas.

Pleasant Home Baptist Church is located five miles east of Gresham at 32120 SE Dodge Park Blvd.

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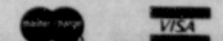
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
