

SUHS board positions up for vote

Sandy Union High School district voters will have the opportunity to elect two members to the district board at the May 11 election.

Two four-year terms will be on the ballot: Position 1, currently held by Dan MacDonald, and Position 4, held by chairman Wayne Johnson.

Although MacDonald was just appointed to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of board member Ralph "Pete" Griffin, district regulations require an election to be held to fill the seat permanently at the first open election.

Interested candidates will be required to file a nominating petition by April 13 at the Clackamas County Courthouse indicating their intention. To file a candidate must gather either 25 signatures from registered voters or pay a \$10 fee.

Nominating petitions are available at the Sandy High School district office in Pioneer Square.

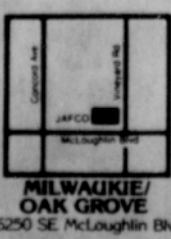
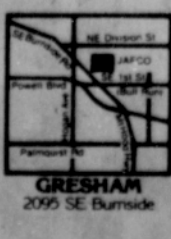
