Woodcutters buy stands

Commercial woodcutters paid an average of \$23 a cord for the right to cut 185 cords of standing lodgepole pine in nine separate firewood sales on the Zigzag Ranger District last week.

Forty-two woodcutters gathered to bid on the nine sales which ranged in size from nine cords to 39 cords. The lowest bid was \$20.16 for a 19-cord sale. The highest bid was \$32.50 a cord for nine cords.

All of the sale areas are located on Highway 26, between Rhododendron and Government Camp.

On March 30, Ray Schoppert of Schoppert Logging was the apparent high bidder on the Nord Special Salvage Timber Sale located on North Mountain near Brightwood. Schoppert bid \$180 per 1,000 board feet for Douglas fir on the 500,000 board foot sale.
