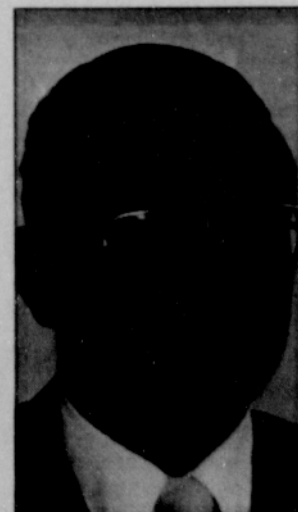
Harvey Lynch is the vice-president of the Miss Oregon Scholarship Pageant Board
