Condomine, played by Dick Trotter is faced with one hilarious adventure after another as the pestering spirit re-enters his life shortly after he takes a new bride (Kathy Marchant).

Noel Coward describes this play as "an improbable farce", and while the events in the show are unlikely to happen in real life, producer Pauline Stafford says it is unlikely that the laughs will be held back during this production.

"Nancy Souther (the director) has done a great job and is bringing out some great performances from this cast."

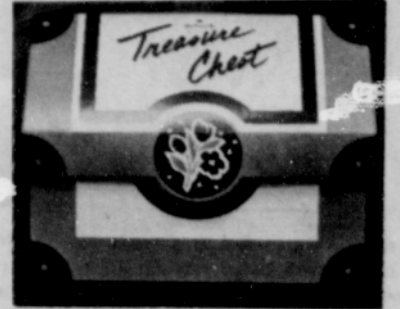


