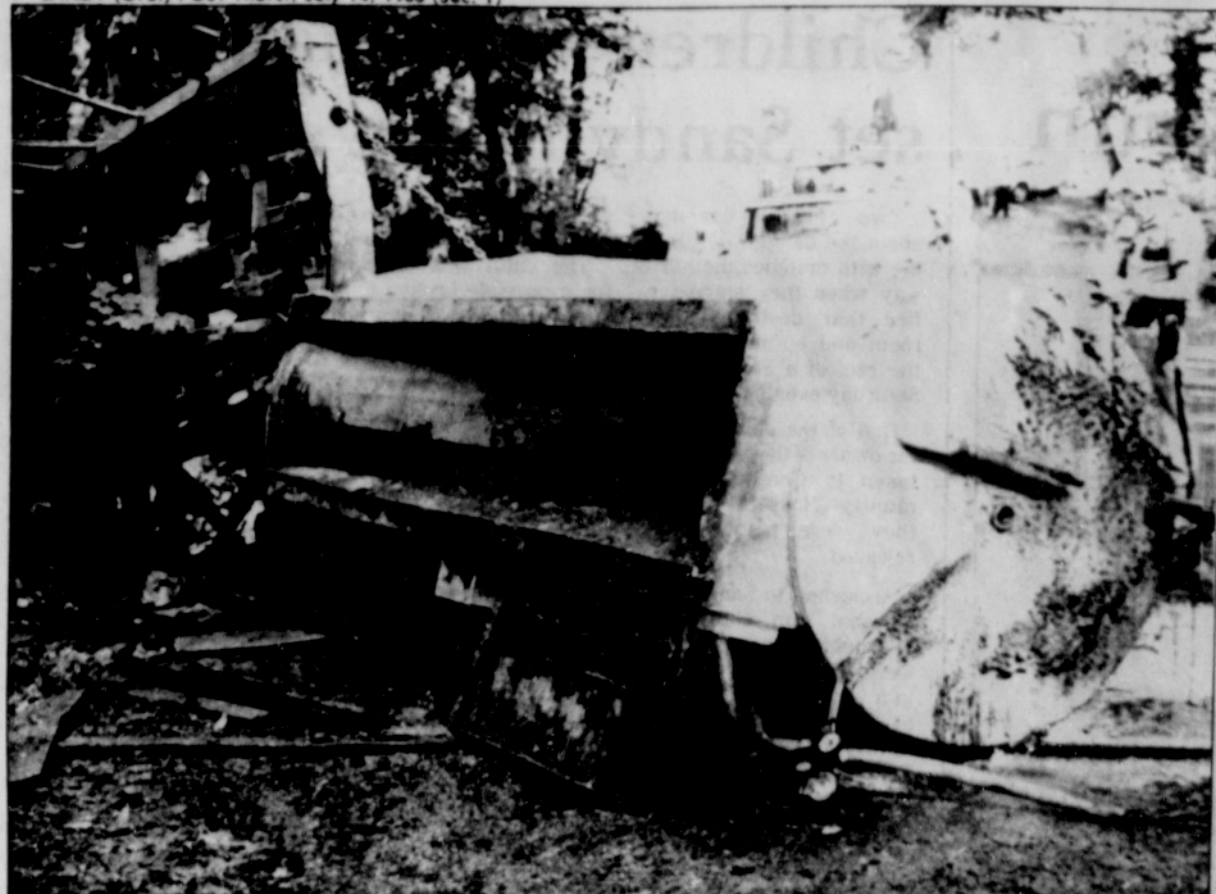

Spill threatens Deep Creek

Concern about a possible fish kill resulting from a dairy truck accident Monday in which 1,350 gallons of liquid manure spilled into a tributary of Deep Creek lessened Tuesday. But officials still warned residents about drinking or swimming in the creek south of Sandy.

According to Janet Gillaspie, information officer for the Department of Environmental Quality, no fish were killed at the site. Some concern remains, however, about the danger of fish dying further downstream. Manure absorbs oxygen from the water, suffocating the fish.

The accident occurred Monday morning on Bornstedt Road, about a quarter mile from its intersection with Rude Road, when the brakes on a dairy truck failed and the liquid manure spilled out of the 1,500-gallon tank into the creek.

The driver of the truck, Philip Allan Gzik, 30, of Sandy suffered a minor cut

on his head and was treated at the scene by Sandy Fire District personnel.

The truck crashed into a tree and overturned in the woods alongside the road while the tank lay across the road, blocking one lane of traffic.

Shortly after the accident, Walt and Denise Driscoll, who live about 100 yards from the crash scene began dipping the small creek for fish trapped in the polluted water. They transferred the trout to a stream across Bornstedt Road that was uncontaminated.

The truck was owned by Cousin's Dairy and Clackamas County sheriff's deputy David Fennell said the owner, Phillip Cousins, would be cited for allowing operation of an unsafe vehicle.

The fire department later cleaned the road and flushed the creek to aerate the water as much as possible. Gillaspie suggested people to stay out of the water for a couple of days.



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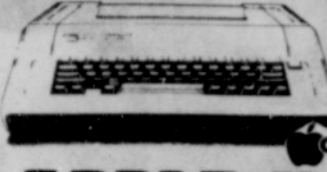
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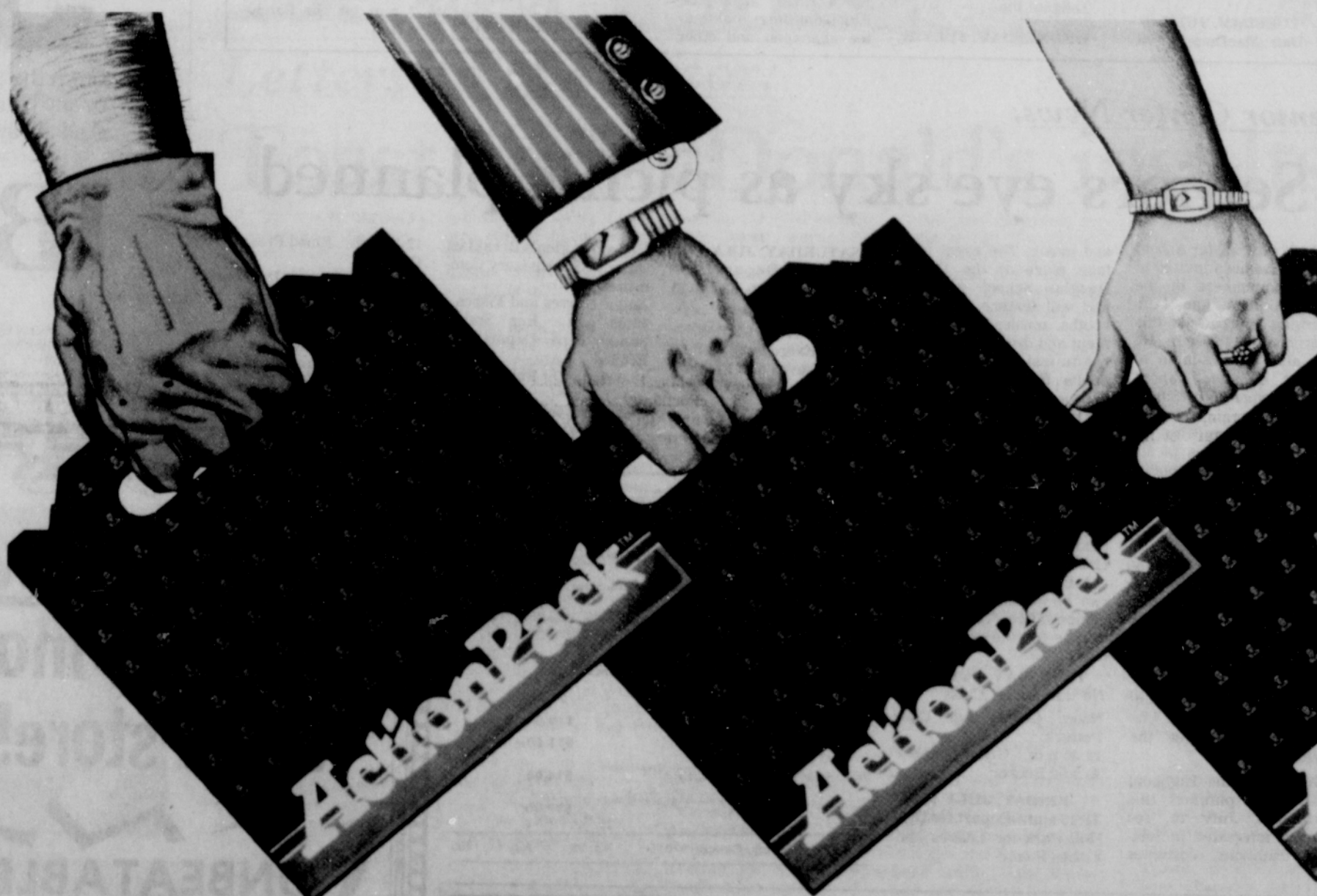
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
