

Cottrell routes set

Cottrell School District announced its bus schedules for the coming year.

Locally, administrators from Sandy Elementary, Sandy Union High School and Bull Run School districts are ironing out the final touches on a cooperative busing plan among the three districts. Look for those bus schedules in next week's edition of The Post.

COTTRELL SCHOOL

Cottrell School's buses will be operated by School Bus Services in Gresham. As last year, the district will coordinate its morning and afternoon schedules with Barlow High School to save money on transportation of students.

Students in grades 1 through 8 will leave school together at 3:25 p.m. No primary bus will run at 2:15 p.m.

BUS 1 MORNING ROUTE: Leaves school at 7:45 a.m., traveling east on Bluff Road toward Sandy, to bus turn-around by Danielson's Nursery; return on Bluff to Virginia Court and turn around; cross Bluff Road traveling west on Hauglum Road to 362nd and

turn around; return east on Hauglum to Bluff, turn left and travel to Hudson Road; turn right on Hudson Road to Lusted Road.

Turn left on Lusted Road and travel to bus turn-around near county line; return on Lusted Road to Dodge Park Boulevard, turn right on Dodge Park Boulevard and travel to 347th; turn left on 347th to Bluff Road; turn left on Bluff and return to school about 8:20 a.m.

BUS 1 AFTERNOON ROUTE: Grades 1-8 will ride this bus home. Bus will follow same route in afternoon as morning run, leaving school at 3:25 p.m.

Kindergarten parents will pick up their youngsters at the West School Building at 11:50 a.m.

BUS 2 MORNING ROUTE: Bus will travel east on Bluff Road, leaving school at 7:50 a.m. to pick up students in grades 4-8. It will pick up students from Belcher's to 352nd. Bus will turn right on 352nd and travel to Compton Road; turn right on Compton Road, picking up students as it travels west to Orient Drive where bus will turn around and return to Comp-

ton, traveling west to 352nd; turn left on 352nd to Hauglum; turn right on Hauglum and travel to 362nd; turn left on 362nd going through trailer court and then to school, arriving about 8:20 a.m.

Bus 2 will then leave school at 8:25 a.m. to pick up students in kindergarten through 3rd grade. It will travel west on Bluff Road to Houston's turn-around; return on Bluff Road, traveling east to 352nd; turning right on 352nd to Compton Road; returning on Compton to 352nd; turning left on 352nd to Hauglum; turning right on Hauglum to 362nd; left on 362nd through trailer court and to school arriving about 8:50 a.m.

BUS 2 AFTERNOON ROUTE: Grades 1-8 will ride the bus down 362nd to trailer court, leaving school at 3:25 p.m. Bus will return to Bluff Road and turn left on Bluff to 352nd. Bus will follow same routes as listed above; when completed trip down 362nd, bus will turn left on Bluff Road and deliver student living between 352nd and Belcher's on way back to Gresham bus lot.

New teachers begin duties

Four teachers — two returning and two new — join Sandy Elementary School District's roster of full-time classroom teachers this year.

Connie Kinder, who worked at Sandy Elementary School last year on a one-year contract, will teach second grade at Kelso School this year. She replaces Doris Richards who retired.

Pam Beasley, who was also at Sandy Elementary School last year, moves to Kelso School this year as well. She will teach special education, replacing Amy Walker who left the school district.

Tom Fearing comes to the Sandy Elementary School District after a year of specialization at West Linn High School.

He will teach special education at Cedar Ridge School. Prior to his West Lin experience, Fearing taught at the junior high level for two years.

Jody Gaspervich will also join Cedar Ridge School. She will teach language arts. A recent graduate of Lewis and Clark College where she specialized in teaching of

English, Gaspervich has traveled throughout Europe and taught temporarily last spring at Parkrose High School.

The two new teachers at Cedar Ridge will be greeted by the largest enrollment ever at the school. School officials are expecting about 420 students.

At Welches school, there will be just one addition in the teaching staff. Julie Hunt, who currently works in the Gresham School district, will be the school's half-time speech therapist.
