

## Pioneers defeated by nine-ranked Gresham

Vandals who cut electrical wires at Sandy's Pop Rannow Stadium may have thought it was the only way to keep Gresham off the scoreboard. The scoreboard was repaired before the varsity game however, and the Gophers put 30 points up Friday night while holding Sandy scoreless.

With the win, ninth-ranked Gresham remains undefeated in Mt. Hood Conference football and shares the league lead with fourth-ranked Barlow. The two teams will square off next Friday and one will have to walk away with its first blemish of the season.

There were few blemishes for the Gophers Friday, even though a tough Pioneer defense held them scoreless for most of the first quarter. Sandy's defensive secondary and a strong wind cut short any passing attack for the Gophers in the first quarter but the wind made Sandy pay even more.

The first quarter would have probably been scoreless had not the wind caught a Sandy punt in the closing minutes, with the ball going out of bounds after only 12 yards. Cary Gaylord picked up a first down on the next play and a Mike Palmer pitcut to Shaun Sitzmann resulted in a seven yard scoring run.

The Pioneers started to move as the second quarter began and appeared to

have some momentum going before former Sandy athlete Troy Wolfe broke up a pass to Sandy's Steve Pettingill with nothing but clear field in front of him. Wolfe showed little sentiment to his former teammates, also soring with a TD reception in the fourth quarter.

A 30-0 win was not as easy as it sounds, according to Wolfe.

"The score is a little deceiving," said Wolfe, "I knew they were going to hit hard and they did. They aren't a pushover."

After Wolfe forced the incompletion, Gresham took over. The Pioneer defense toughened to put them at third and 14, but Gaylord again found a hole for a 20 yard first down run, two plays later, Eric Allen stepped into the end zone with a twisting 7-yard run.

Penalties went the right way for Gresham as 30 yard pass to Sandy's Loren Bateman was called back on fourth down and pass interference was called on Sandy on the next play.

"We had three straight penalties to set up that scoring drive for them," said offensive coordinator Randy Hutchinson.

"We can't be making those kind of mistakes against a team of this caliber."

It wasn't all roses for the Gophers as a Pioneer interception had a penalty

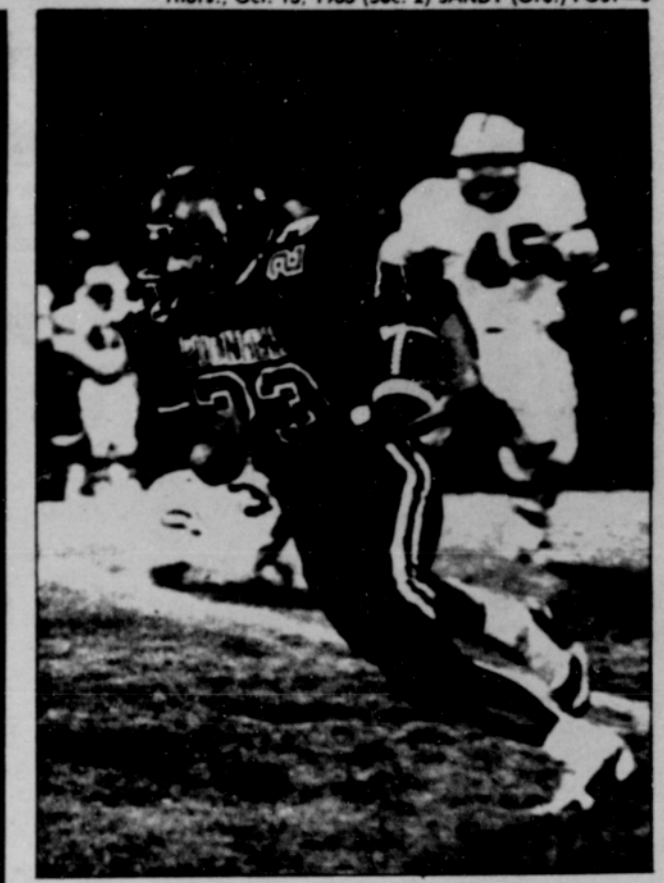
