Realtor presents safety programs

Pioneer Realty, as part of a statewide effort sponsored by the Oregon Association of Realtors, has or will present safety programs for first graders at Firwood, Sandy, Kelso and Cottrell schools.

Dale Nicholls of Pioneer Real Estate presented the short program Friday at Firwood School.

He called the safety presentation a "very well done piece of material."

It includes a 16-minute film strip and cassette, and at the end of the program youngsters receive a "Safety Through Songs" coloring book, which comes with a record and words to the songs.

"I think it is a particularly good thing for these kids, especially with Halloween coming up," Nicholls said.

The booklet contains the sheet music for songs such as "Look Both Ways," "Traffic Lights," "My Bicycle," "Strangers" and "Water Safety."

One song, "Officer Ugg," urges youngsters to be careful around household poisons. It goes, in part, "Certain things can make you sick, and do great harm to you. So always think before you touch, it's

very smart to do." "It was something we felt strongly motivated about,"

said Nicholls, who has seen similar presentations in Phoenix, Ariz., and

Pendleton. He said he hopes the presentation is fun as well as educational.
