Around the World in a Day may disappoint a lot of Prince fans simply because it doesn't always sound like a Prince album. Folk music replaces funk in some songs and there is even a cello instead of a fuzz-tone guitar.

But Prince hasn't gone tame. One listen to the scorching Jimi-Hendrix-gone-funky "America" will reassure fans of Prince's dedication to pure rock n' roll.
