## Woman to participate in pageant

Two scholarship pageants are on tap this weekend for Sandy and East County area residents.

At 8 p.m. Friday, six young women will compete for the titles of Miss Multnomah County and Miss Metro East. The pageant will be held in the David Douglas High School Performing Arts Center, 1500 S.E. 130th Ave.

On Saturday, also at 8 p.m. in the Performing Arts Center, the Miss Mt. Hood Area Scholarship Pageant will decide the winner from six young

women vying for the Miss Mount Hood area and Miss Clackamas County crown.

Tickets for each event are \$5 in advance and \$6 at the door.

Both scholarship pageants are affiliated with the Miss Oregon Pageant — and, therefore, the Miss America event.

In October, young women 16-26 years of age apply to enter the contests. Entry is open through Jan. 1, after which the competition begins.

Young women competing for the

four titles must first pass the preliminary competition. These women, says pageant producer Vicki Gunderson, then vie in this weekend's pageants.

Gunderson said the exact scholarship awards have not yet been announced.

The contestants have been rehearsing for this weekend's pageants for four months, she said.

Once a week they receive lessons in how to sit, stand, walk and talk and build confidence and poise, Gunder-

son said.

In addition, experts in the areas of make-up, hair styling, wardrobe selection, fundamentals of grooming, posture and color analysis make presentations to the pageant candidates.

Candidates for the Miss Mt. Hood Area and Miss Clackamas County pageants include Lori Lagasse, 20, a 1983 graduate of Sandy High School who plans to attend MHCC majoring in performance and broadcasting.
