

## 1985 JUDGES PANEL LOOKING FOR MISS AMERICA!!!

With the Miss Mt. Hood Area and Miss Multnomah County Scholarship Pageants being official preliminaries of the Miss America Pageant, the judges will be keeping a watchful eye open for that young woman who has the qualities to become the first Miss America from the State of Oregon. With that in mind, the judging will take place starting with interviews on Friday, June 14th at David Douglas High School. After interviews, the contestants will be able to relax until that evening when the balance of the competition will take place for the Miss Multnomah County Contestants; and Saturday evening, June 15th for the Miss Mt. Hood Area Contestants. Judges will be looking for the "potential" of each girl in talent, swimsuit, evening gown, and the private interview competition which makes up the categories being judged.

This years judges have the task of selecting the winners who will go on to compete in the 1986

Miss Oregon Pageant, with that possibility of then heading towards Atlantic City to vie for the crown of Miss America.

This years judging panel includes Harvey Lynch, of Seaside, who is the Vice President of the Miss Oregon Pageant and has been involved in pageantry since 1968; Pat Benson, of Portland, who has been the Co-Director of the Miss Portland Pageant for the past six years, as well as program director and chaperone the four years previous; Carol O'Donovan of Seaside, who has been active with the Miss Oregon Pageant since 1973; Bill Ross who is active in the Miss T.E.E.N. Pageants, and whose daughter is the 1981 Miss Oregon; and Helen Landers of Burns, who is the the Chairperson for the Miss Harney County Fair and Rodeo Court and the Chairperson for the Miss High Desert Pageant.

Both pageants will be held at the David Douglas High School Performing Arts Center, 1500 S.E. 130th at 8:00 P.M.
