New music director named

Dr. Philip T. Cansler, assistant professor of music and band director at the University of Portland since 1980, has been appointed director of the Mt. Hood Pops Orchestra.

Cansler conducts the wind and jazz ensembles at the University of Portland and was appointed coordinator of the music merchandising and management degree program in 1982.

The Mt. Hood Pops Orchestra will resume rehearsals on Sept. 26. "Members of the orchestra come from all walks of life, but have in common a love for music and the ability to play a musical instrument competently," said Carol Cole, Pops president.

The orchestra will perform at least three free concerts during the 1985-86 season: Nov. 3, Feb. 23 and May 18. The Sunday concerts will be at 3 p.m. in the Mt. Hood Community College auditorium.

Cansler is the author of "Twentieth Century Music for Trumpet and Organ" and has written several articles in state and national journals on music education and performance topics.

As a trumpeter, Cansler has performed in symphony orchestras, concert bands and jazz groups throughout the Midwest and Northwest. He was principal trumpeter of the Festconcert Orchestra in Eisenstadt, Austria, in the summer of 1979.

Cansler has been director of bands at Buena Vista College in Storm Lake, Iowa, and has taught at elementary and secondary schools in Topeka, Kansas, and Eugene, Ore.

Cansler received his bachelor of music in education from Washburn University in Topeka and his master's and doctor of music degrees from the University of Oregon.

He also has studied at Arizona State University, the University of Kansas and Haydn Konservatorie of Musik in Austria.

Cansler's name appears in The Outstanding Young Men of America, International Who's Who in Music and Musicians Directory, the International Youth in Achievement, Men

of Achievement, Who's Who in American Music and the International Directory of Distinguished Young Leadership.

He currently is working on a teaching method book called "CPR

for Trumpet."

Graduates of Gresham High are urged to "Gopher It."

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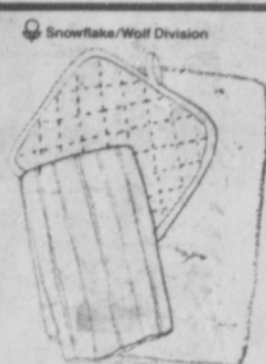
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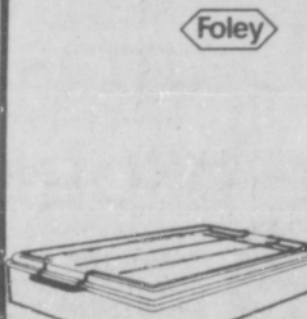
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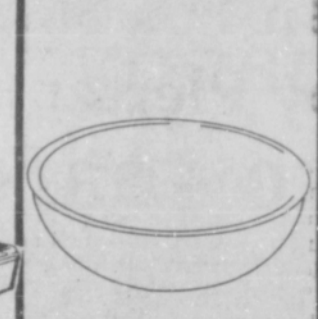
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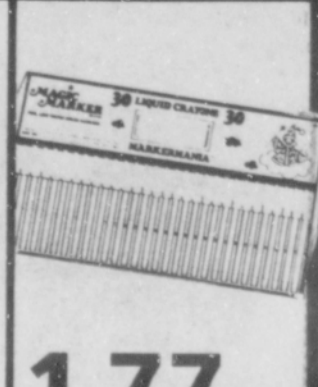
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
