NOTICE OF HEARING ON PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS FOR HOODLAND SERVICE AREA CLACKAMAS COUNTY SERVICE DISTRICT NO. 1

Clackamas County Service District No. 1 will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, August 22, 1985 at 10:00 a.m. in the Clackamas County Courthouse Annex, 906 Main Street, Oregon City, Oregon, to hear remonstrances and consider objections to a proposal to construct improvements to the District's sewer system and to assess a portion of the cost of such improvements to properties benefitted by the improvements.

The proposed improvements are in the Welches and Rhododendron areas of the Hoodland Service Area. They include construction of the Fairway Interceptor sewer system in the Welches area, to provide service to an unserved area and to connect to the existing Mt. Hood Golf Club Terrace collection system. They also include construction of the remaining portion of the North Welches Interceptor sewer system, to serve unserved areas in the upper northeast portion of the Welches area and in the Rhododendron commercial area.

An engineer's report describing the proposed improvements, giving the estimated cost of the project, proposing the method of assessment, describing the property to be assessed and containing estimated assessments for each affected parcel has been approved. The report may be examined by any person on any day, Monday through Friday, between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., at the office of the Clackamas County Department of Utilities, 902 Abernathy Road, Oregon City, Oregon.

Written remonstrances may be filed against the proposed improvement by the owners of property to be specially benefitted. Such remonstrances must be filed at the office of the Director, Clackamas County Department of Utilities, at the address above stated not later than at the time of the conclusion of the above stated hearing. If remonstrances or objections are received by the District prior to the conclusion of the hearing by more than fifty percent (50%) of the owners of land representing more than fifty percent (50%) of the land within the proposed Assessment District, the proposed improvement shall not be made.

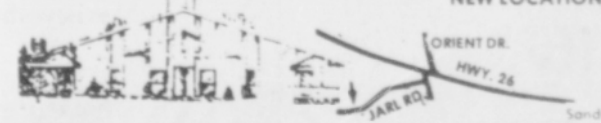
