participated in the America's Junior Miss program in Mobile, Ala.

At Mobile, everything was first class, Neel reports, from the "Hersey chocolate party" on the USS Alabama to the tours of Dauphin Island in the Gulf of Mexico and the Oakleigh Mansion.

The Junior Miss program grew out of Mobile's azalea festival and is in its 27th year; Oregon is one year behind.

Even at the national level, the atmosphere was "friendly," Neel said. "We wanted everybody to do their best. It wasn't cutthroat, as you might expect."

Local organizers are hoping the Z-100 Morning Zoo Crew — truly wild and crazy disc jockeys for an FM rock station — will help bring the young people out to this year's program. They have agreed to serve as emcees.

When they learned that Neel sang Cole Porter's "Anything Goes" in Junior Miss competition, one of them sat down and wrote his own version. A half an hour later, he asked her to sing his version.

She did, and a sample of the lyrics are:

"They're wild," said Neel, recalling her recent visit to the station.

The girls may be in it for the fun, too, but Reese — the person who originally got the Millers interested in Junior Miss — participates because she enjoys meeting and getting to know the girls. They are the "leaders, the ones who are helping with service groups, church, the handicapped. It makes you feel good to know 'em."

Reese, of Tigard, said that out of 33 girls at the state program last year, the cumulative grade point average was 3.67, and that was with a lot of extra-curricular activities thrown in.

This year's Sandy Junior Miss program will be Saturday, Sept. 14 at the Sandy High School commons. Ten SUHS seniors will be participating.

She created The Loft Gallery in Beaverton when she worked as buyer and director of the social division of the J. Thayer Co. The Loft Gallery featured Northwest artists.

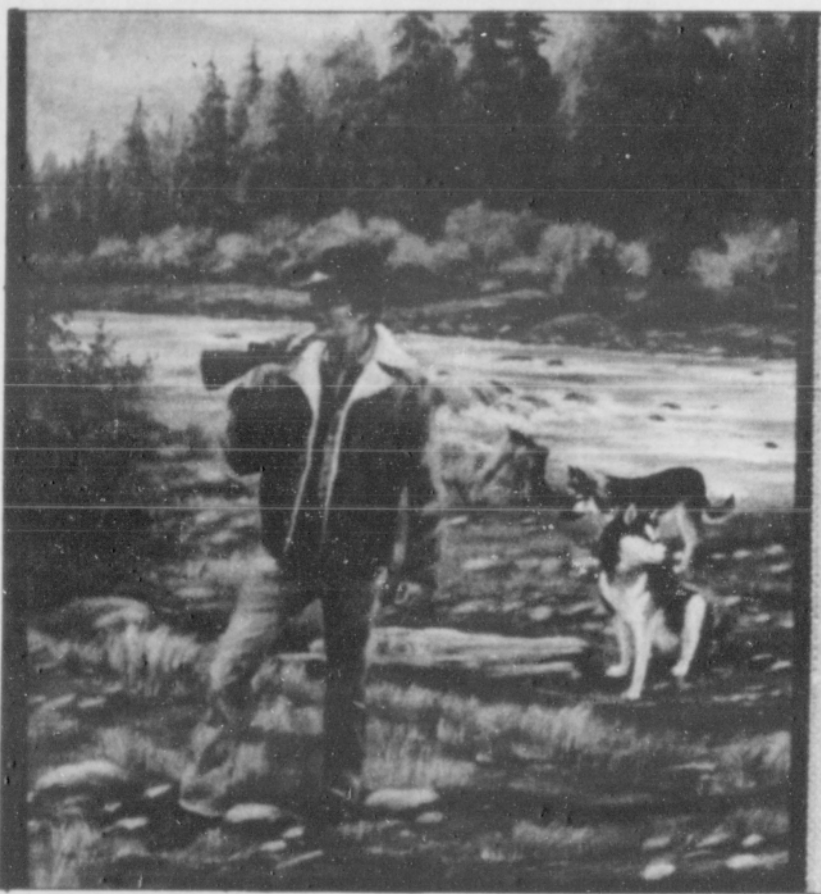
