

Plant bulbs in late summer, fall

Like spring bulbs, herbaceous flowering perennials such as peonies, iris or daylily can be planted in late summer or fall.

Herbaceous perennials are plants with fleshy and hardy stems, and root systems that go dormant during the winter. Perennials come back to life and begin growing and blooming again in the following spring and summer.

A herbaceous perennial is not the same as flowering bulb plants like tulips or daffodils, says Ray McNeilan, Oregon State University Extension home gardening agent. Herbaceous perennials do not store food for the plant in the same way that bulbs do.

However, herbaceous perennials

can be planted in late August, September or October, where fall weather is mild. Fall plantings of perennials will have time to become established before cold winter weather arrives. In the spring these plantings will begin growing and blooming vigorously.

Since a perennial will occupy the same planting site for many years to come, a good planting bed is important to the future quality of the plant, McNeilan says. Spade the planting area to a depth of 8 to 12 inches. Rake the soil level and add 2 to 4 inches of organic matter such as cow manure, compost or peat moss.

Plant perennials at the same level they were grown as transplants. There should be a soil line low down

on the stem of the plant that will serve as a guide.

The plant roots need space to spread out properly. Dig a hole a bit larger in diameter than the spread of

the plant roots. Build a small cone of soil in the bottom of the hole and set the plant gently on the cone, letting the roots spread out naturally in all directions from the main stem.
