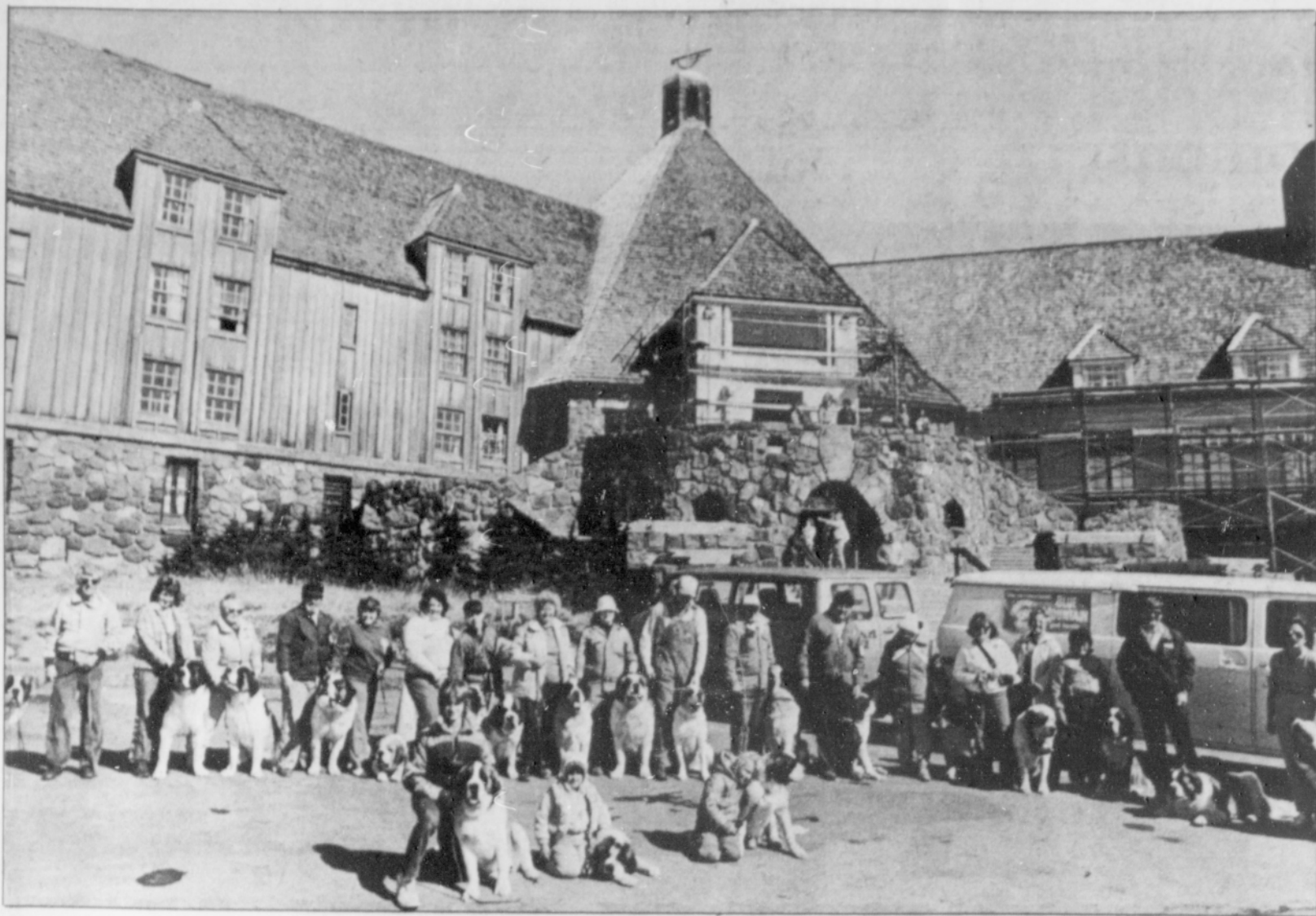




Going to the dogs

Cut-ups/celebrate 25th anniversary

BORING — A lot of anniversary parties have been held at the Boring Barn on Southeast Richey Road. But the one planned for Saturday night is special.

It will mark the 25th anniversary of the Country Cut-Ups, the square dance club that owns the barn and holds dances there twice a month. Visitors are welcome and admission is \$5 per couple.

The Country Cut-Ups had its beginnings in January 1960 when members of the Damascus Grange at Boring decided they wanted to try their feet at square dancing. The club's 64 original members — enough for eight squares — learned to square dance at the grange hall under the direction of caller Don Jones. But they wanted a place of their own, and in 1962 they purchased the Boring Barn, formerly the play shed on what once was the site of the Boring School.
