\$2.00 will be awarded to the Champion Large Fowl, Bantam, Duck and Goose.

QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS:

All awards shall be made to members of the American Poultry Association.

All judging shall be by the latest edition of the American Standard of Perfection; copyright American Poultry Association.

To win the medals, there must be ten (10) entries competing.

The Association invites you to become a member. Annual membership is \$6.00; two years - \$10.00; Junior members - \$3.00; two years - \$5.00. Application may be made at the show prior to judging or to the American Poultry Association, Box 351, R.D. No. 4, Troy, N.Y. 12180.

Rabbits will be accepted in the showroom from 6 p.m. to 10 p.m., Monday, the day before the Fair. All rabbits MUST be in place by 7:30 a.m. Tuesday, as judging begins promptly at 8:00 a.m. ALL VEHICLES MUST BE REMOVED FROM RABBIT AREA BY 8 a.m. Tuesday and placed in designated parking lots. NO VEHICLES WILL BE ALLOWED IN RABBIT AREA DURING THE FAIR. No Exceptions.

This is an official A.R.B.A. Sanctioned Show. The show will be governed by the latest A.R.B.A. rules. (Official show rules are in your latest yearbook.) We urge you to acquaint yourself with these rules. Awards will be placed on all breeds of rabbits recognized by the Standard of Perfection of the A.R.B.A. No cross breeds are allowed in A.R.B.A. shows.

All disqualifications, eliminations and general faults will apply to all classes, including meat pens and single fryers.

1. Competition in all classes is open to the world.
2. Diseased specimens will not be accepted and entry forfeited.

3. Rabbits will be judged in the class as entered on the entry form.

Please make out your entries carefully and double check them.

4. All entries must be identified by permanent and legible tattoo in the left ear to correspond with that on the entry form, or charge of 50¢ each will be made for the marking.

5. Any exhibitor who disrupts or interferes in any way is subject to having their stock removed from the show room and will forfeit any premiums due them. The judges decisions and remarks are final. Any disagreements will be settled after all the judging is completed. Upon receipt of your entry blank, it will be assumed that you understand and agree to abide by all the rules for the betterment of the competition of raising and showing rabbits.

6. Pen of live fryers consists of three fryers, weight limit 5 lbs.

7. Pre-Junior Classes, heavyweight.

8. Single Fryer Class, 5 lbs.

9. Any changes or specials will be posted in the Rabbit Building.

Open Class
10. All stock must be sold by owner. No stock to leave show room until release time.
11. No breeding in show room and no change of ear number.
12. RELEASE time 9:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. Sunday, the last day of the Fair. Rabbits must be hand carried from fairgrounds. No vehicles will be allowed through the gates while fair patrons are present.
13. Sale of small animals from Rabbit, Poultry, & Kiddieland can only be delivered at release time, Sunday evening, 9:00 to 10:00 P.M.
