## Frank Tobias

Sandy resident Frank John Tobias died in Gresham on Aug. 15 at the age of 66.

Recitation of the Rosary was held Monday, Aug. 18. Funeral Mass was said Tuesday at St. Michael Catholic Church in Sandy. Concluding services were at Sandy Ridge Cemetery.

Mr. Tobias was born in Vibank, Saskatchewan, Canada, on Jan. 23, 1920. He was raised at Vibank where he began working on the family farm at an early age.

On June 2, 1942, he married Veronica M. Sali in Vibank. They took over the operation of the family farm at Vibank, which they ran until 1946, when they moved to Oregon.

Making their home in the Boring area, Mr. Tobias worked several jobs until 1948, when he began working for Fanning Chevrolet in Gresham. At the automobile dealership, he began

as a mechanic and later as service manager and then worked in the sales department.

In 1963, he began working in real estate sales in the Portland area. Later, in 1966, he began Tobias Realty in Portland, which he worked until selling the business and retiring in 1977.

After retiring, they moved to the Sandy area to make their permanent home. Mrs. Tobias preceded him in death in 1984.

He was a member of St. Michael Catholic Church, and was active in the church. After moving here, he enjoyed raising cattle, traveling and socializing with people.

He is survived by a son, Leonard Tobias of Sandy; two sisters, Mary Bohn and Anne Fink, both of Saskatchewan, Canada; and three grandchildren.

## Paul Buuck

A memorial for longtime Sandy resident Paul Leonard Buuck was held Wednesday at Carroll Funeral Home in Gresham.

Mr. Buuck died Aug. 17 at a Portland hospital. He was 85.

He was born on Nov. 3, 1900, in Newberg. He moved to Sandy in 1932. He married Mary Retalleck in Vancouver, Wash., on April 10, 1953.

He farmed in Sandy until about two years ago when he moved to Troutdale. His wife died Jan. 14, 1985.

He enjoyed farming and loved his

farm animals.

He is survived by his stepchildren, Burnis McClanahan of Troutdale, Jim Goff of Sandy and Frances Wright of Portland; a sister, Christine Freeman of McMinnville; and many step-grandchildren and step-great-grandchildren.

Eugenia Boitano, a Sandy resident for 74 years, died in Gresham on Aug. 12 at the age of 96.

Mrs. Boitano was born Eugenia Teresa Garbarini in Goreto, Italy, on July 19, 1890. She was raised in Italy and at the age of 22 came to the United States.

After her marriage to Mario J. Boitano on Dec. 6, 1912, they made

their home near Sandy where they began their family.

Mr. Boitano died in 1933. Eugenia remained at their farm south of Sandy where she raised dairy cattle while raising their children. After the children were grown she worked caring for the elderly in Portland.

Mrs. Boitano was a member of St. Michael Catholic Church and the Sandy Senior Center. She enjoyed flowers and gardening.

She is survived by her children: Olga Holloway and Mario Gene Boitano, both of Sandy; a sister, Carmella Garbarini, in Italy; nine grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren.
