Kiwanis Club begins food collection

For the past 25 years, the Kiwanis Club of Sandy has sponsored a Christmas Basket project. The club regards the project as an all-community effort in which the club offers leadership and organization.

The Kiwanis Club is asking all boys and girls and all adults to "lend a

hand," said W. Pete Sulzbach, chairman of the Christmas Basket committee.

The end goal is to provide approximately 200 "baskets," which are really boxes generously packed with fresh, canned and packaged foods, plus toys and other gifts for children.

The "baskets" will be picked up by some recipients and delivered to others on Saturday morning, Dec. 20.

Goal of the food drive is to collect about 7,000 cans of food or more, in addition to other items.

Sandy Community Action Center will start processing applications for

the "baskets" on Dec. 1. They will help in economical purchase of certain foods and will provide many gifts for children. The Sandy Fire District will be willing to accept toys and other gifts for this project. Sandy Community Action Center will also act as a drop-off place for toys and other gifts.

The area served will encompass the enrollment areas of Sandy Elementary, Kelso, Bull Run, Cottrell, Cedar Ridge and most of the Sandy High's area.

The Boring Fire District will lead a similar project for the Boring and Damascus school enrollment areas.

John M. Macy of Boring, a grandson, is the only local survivor.

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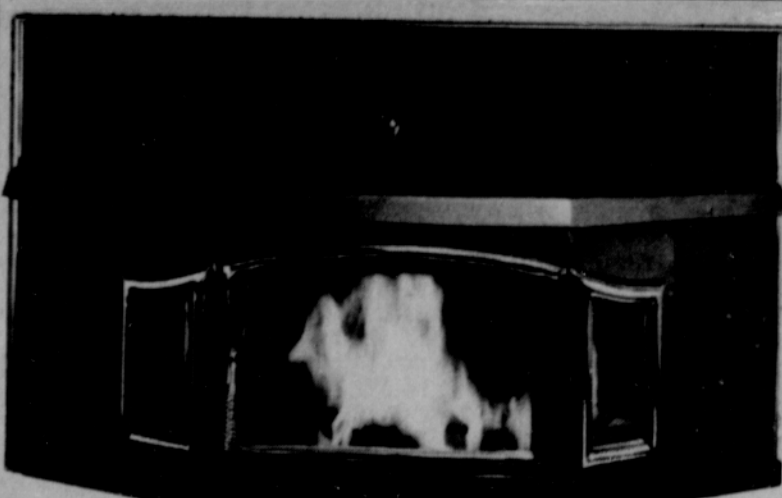

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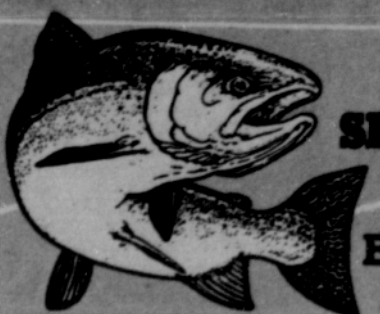
