It's Turkey Carving Time!

These simple, easy-to-follow steps will take the mystery out of carving turkey, duck or any type of poultry!

1. When turkey is done, remove stuffing and place bird on a wooden carving board. Let stand for about 20 minutes.

2. With carving fork, steady the turkey and pull the leg away from the body.

3. Place boning knife into the socket of the leg joint and cut off leg.

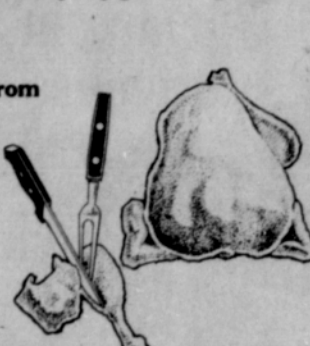


5. Next, locate the wing joint and slice through the skin until you feel the bone. Pull the wing down then cut off and separate at the joint.

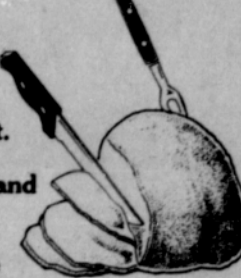
6. With your carving knife, make an incision across the body of the turkey from wingbone to wishbone.



4. To separate drumstick from the thigh, slice through the joint, and carve the meat from each piece if desired.



7. Steady the bird with your fork and with long, smooth strokes, start slicing above the leg socket. Begin to carve thin, even slices down to the incision and start each new slice a little higher, until you reach the breastbone. (The angle of your knife will change slightly until you're slicing almost parallel to breastbone.)
