Super Bowl teams

It was no surprise the New York Giants made it to the Super Bowl. But the Denver Broncos did surprise a few. They won their Super Bowl ticket in overtime against the Cleveland Browns.

The Giants are rolling and may not stop until the Super Bowl title is theirs. During regular season play the Giants and the Broncos have split wins. The Giants beat Denver 19-16 and the Broncos edged the Giants 31-30.

Broncos' Elway, 26, was called the

Since the '84 season he's made good things happen. A confident player, Simms can take a game to the wire and make the Giants a winner.

He's finally made fans with New York — they like the way he has shaped the Giants, and they want a Super Bowl winner.

The winner of Super Bowl XXI will be no surprise. Each team has a solid quarterback, an offense to back them up, and defensive linemen to make the other team worry.
