Rhonda Bisacre of Boring was the maid of honor. Bridesmaids were

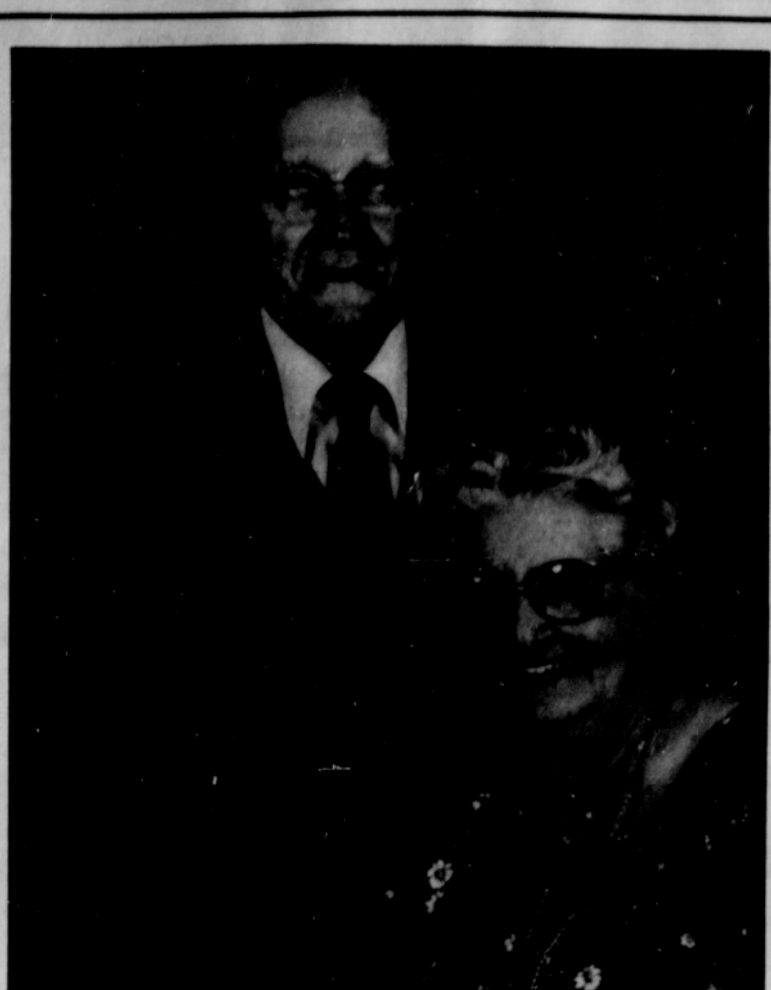
Kelly Lowe of Troutdale, the groom's sister, Sue Huffington of Gresham and Nanette Pirisky of Las Vegas, Nev.

Students demonstrate on King's birthday

CORBETT — A handful of Corbett High School students used Martin Luther King Jr.'s tactic — a peaceful demonstration — to protest the school's non-observance of the black leader's birthday.

The student's staged a sit-in Monday in front of the school at 35800 E. Crown Point Highway. King, a leader of the civil rights movement in the 1960s, used sit-ins to draw attention to his cause. He was assassinated April 4, 1968, in Memphis, Tenn.

King's birthday, Jan. 15, is a national holiday observed the third Monday in January by state and federal agencies. State and federal offices were closed Monday as were some schools.

The Corbett students say they believe Corbett schools also should close in recognition of King's birthday as a national holiday.

"We're not doing it for a free day off," said senior Justin McCauley.

Nor were they trying to get out of Monday's classes. But Martin Luther King Jr. is a man who deserves recognition, he said.

So the students decided to work toward that goal the same way King would: by peaceful means. They wanted to conduct themselves in the same manner he would, said student Jayson Thorning.

Principal Larry McClellan did not interfere with their action. "The kids I've talked to are real sincere about this," he said.

"I'm in a sense supporting their demonstration in that I'm allowing them to do it," McClellan said.

He told the students that the school board decides what holidays are observed by school closure and recommended they draft a letter to the board. The letter should be ratified by the student council, he told them, then presented to the board.

"I think they're taking a real responsible look at our society and what it stands for," McClellan said.
