WHEREAS a petition has been received duly signed by the required number of qualified voters of Clackamas County, Oregon, praying that the following described territory be excluded from School District No. 2 (Sandy Union High), Clackamas County, Oregon, and included in School District No. UH2-20Jr. (Gresham Union High), Multnomah and Clackamas Counties, Oregon:

A tract of land situated in the southwest one-quarter of Section 36, Township 1 South, Range 3 East of the Willamette Meridian in the County of Clackamas and State of Oregon, more particularly described as follows:

Any person interested in this change of school district boundaries is invited to be present at the hearing.

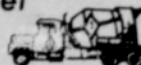
