Two join board of Rainier Bank Oregon

Two local businessmen are on the board of directors of Rainier Bank Oregon, which has merged its banking operations to create a commercial bank with assets of more than \$360 million.

Among the directors is G. Adolph Hertrich, president of Vanport Manufacturing Inc. of Boring, and J. Frank Schmidt Jr., president of J. Frank Schmidt and Sons Co., a wholesale grower of deciduous shade

and flowering trees with its headquarters in Boring.

Hertrich and Schmidt were formerly directors for Mount Hood Security Bank, which had two branch offices in Gresham. Stockholders of

Mount Hood Security Bank voted last fall to approve a merger with Rainier Bank Oregon.

Rainier recently merged its Federal Savings Bank with its existing wholesale banking operation.

The three-masted, 100-foot-long ship was built in England in 1973 at a cost of \$15 million. The same kinds of materials and fine craftsmanship used to build the Golden Hinde 400 years ago were utilized to build the replica.

A crew of 14 people sailed the new "Golden Hinde" around the world following Drake's route and now make it available for group tours. Four members play host and dress in authentic costumes of the day. Following a guided walk-on tour of the ship and lunch at the Astoria Senior Center, travelers will have a chance to visit the Columbia River Maritime Museum.
