MHC softball action

Gophers defeat Barlow 4-1

Gresham softball pitcher Kim Fisher tossed a two-hitter, struck out five batters and hit a triple as the Gophers downed Barlow 4-1 Tuesday in Mount Hood Conference play.

"We still made errors and that could have made the difference," said Gresham coach Melinda Amelee. "We finally started stroking the ball out into the field, and we were pretty tough defensively."

With Tuesday's win and Monday's eight-inning loss to Central Catholic, the Gophers record stands at 6-2, as does Reynolds and Centennial, at the midpoint of the MHC season. The Rams currently lead the league with a record of 7-1. Barlow is only one game back in third place at 5-3. Columbia, Sandy, David Douglas and Parkrose round out the league.

"It's been tough so far," Amelee said. "There's a ton of us up at the top and in our league you can't relax against anybody."

In Tuesday's game with the Bruins, the first four innings were dominated by the strong pitching of Fisher and Barlow's Colleen Greene. Both pitchers gave up only one hit apiece until Fisher cranked out a triple into center field to open the fourth inning.

Greene struck out the Gophers' next batter, Bev Hartel, before Leanna Helvig hit a slow grounder to Barlow shortstop Kelly Parnell, who tried to throw out Fisher at home plate but was too late.

Helvig was able to advance to second when Bruin catcher Heather Martin mishandled a hot Greene pitch. Right fielder Jana Mitchell

then stroked a single into right field to score Helvig and give the Gophers a 2-0 lead.

"Colleen did a pretty good job pitching today, but we just couldn't get the hits to back her up," said Barlow coach Sharon Flood.

The Bruins collected their only run of the game in the sixth inning. With two outs and runners on second and third, Greene lined a shot which was knocked down by Gresham's second baseman Caroline Earle. At first Earle appeared to have made the catch as she hit the ground, but when she went to get up the ball slipped out of her mitt and the umpire ruled it a hit as Kathy Codanti scored from third. Amelee protested the call, but the play stood as called.

Gresham added some more runs in the top of the seventh when Selby scored on a Bruin throwing error and Hartel hit a triple to score Fisher.

Fisher then slammed the door shut on the Bruins by striking out two of the last three batters to end the game.

"Kim didn't really overpower anybody today," Amelee said. "She pitched a good game and we had some really solid defense to help her out."

"I was really glad to see that the girls played so well after our eight-inning loss to Central Catholic last night," Amelee said. "That was a game that could have gone either way."

Looking ahead to the second half of the season both coaches were optimistic about how their teams would do and felt that hitting and the elimination of errors would be the keys in a team's success.

The Bruins won't have it any easier

today when they travel to Reynolds and Gophers will play Centennial.
