Lisa Izer/ Hans Rosenberry

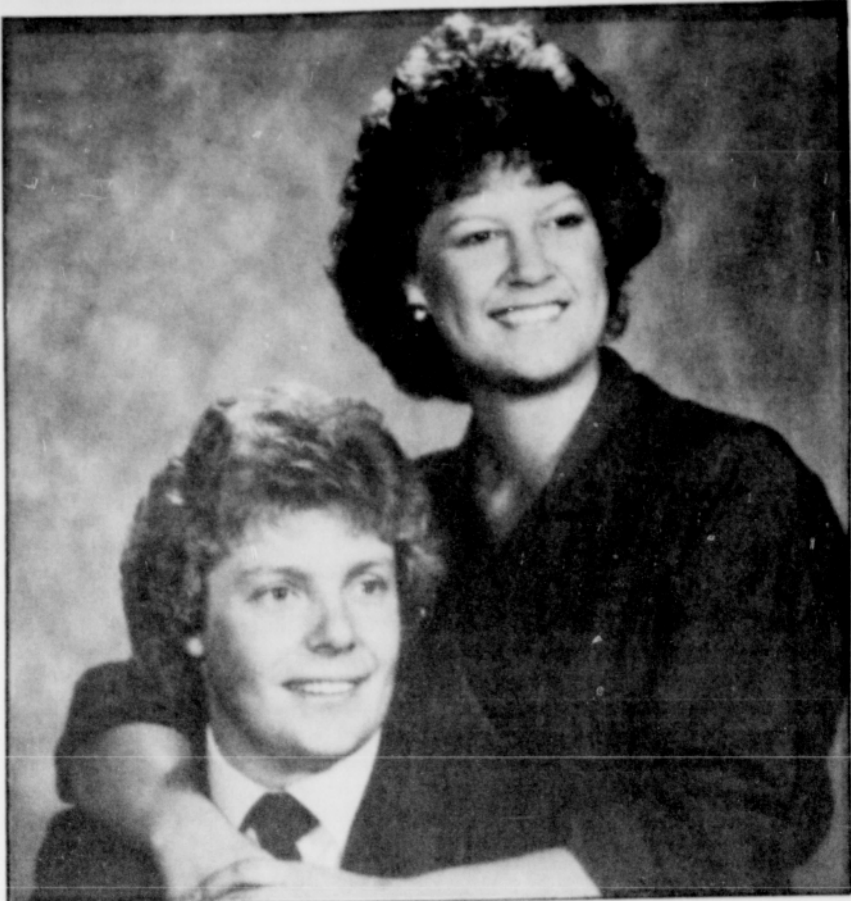
Lisa Ann Izer of Boring and Hans Richard Rosenberry of Caldwell, Idaho, have announced plans for a June 20 wedding.
