Henry Brune

Sandy resident Henry Paul Brune died May 15 at a Gresham care center at the age of 90.

Mr. Brune was born in St. Paul, Minn., on Sept. 20, 1896. He was raised in Minnesota where, after finishing his schooling, he began working as a farmer.

He later owned a Ford dealership with his brother and also was employed as an electrician.

He moved to Oregon in 1929 and lived and farmed in the Portland area.

On Nov. 26, 1935, he married Erma Rebstock. They remained in the Portland area until 1954, when they moved to the Sandy area, where he

had dairy cows, raised beef and grew berries.

After retiring in 1969, they moved to a home south of Sandy. He enjoyed playing the violin, singing and fishing.

He is survived by his wife of 51 years, Erma Brune; two children: Shirley Long of Portland and Lyle Brune of Beaverton; his brother: Ed Brune of Hudson, Wis.; and six grandchildren.

Services were held May 20 at the Community Presbyterian Church. Private entombment was held at Forest Lawn Memorial Park in Gresham. The family suggests memorial contributions be made to the American Cancer Society.

Sandy Funeral Home was in charge of arrangements.

Harry Albert Smith died at his home in Welches on May 14. He was 62.

Mr. Smith was born Jan. 19, 1925, in Pierre, S.D. He was raised in South Dakota, where he enlisted in the U.S. Navy. He served in both World War II and Korea.

After his discharge, he lived in Montana for 10 years prior to moving to Oregon in the early 1960s. He made his permanent home in the Hoodland

area, where he was an avid hunter and fisherman.

He was a member of the Northwest Steelheaders and was known to many people by his CB handle, "35."

Harry worked at various occupations prior to his retirement.

Survivors include his brothers and sisters: Hazel Gaither of Wernme, Howard Smith of Lake Oswego, Hearst Smith of Mulino, Helen Dunham of Boring, Harlon Smith of Sherwood, and Hannah Hall of Meridian, Idaho; and many nieces and nephews.
