Prophecy rings true for UO sophomore

The Sandy High School class of 1985 named Susan Krick the most likely to succeed. They must have known what they were doing.

Krick, a University of Oregon sophomore, was among 105 scholars from across the country to receive the Harry S. Truman scholarship, which is worth up to \$7,000 annually for four years.

The grant will pay tuition, fees, books and room and board during the last two years of undergraduate study and two years of graduate school.

Krick said the scholarship will enable her to go to law school.

She is a political science major who plans to graduate early so she can go to London for a year to serve as a page in the United Kingdom Parliament. After that, she plans to attend Willamette University in Salem to study law.

Krick worked this past summer for Senate President John Kitzhaber, doing research on insurance liability under the direction of Catherine Weber, an attorney.

Krick said she would eventually like to work in public service, though not necessarily in an elected office.

The awards program, administered by the Harry S. Truman Scholarship Foundation, honors outstanding students demonstrating the potential for future leadership in government and related public service.

In applying for the Truman scholarship, Krick wrote a statement of her educational plans and analyzed her previous education. She was

also required to list her past activities and leadership roles.

After submitting her application last winter, Krick was chosen as a semifinalist in January. She traveled to Seattle, Wash., this spring for an interview.

"They tried to create a high-pressure situation," Krick said of the interview. "It was only 35 minutes but it seemed like forever."

Krick was notified of her selection as a scholar in mid-April.

"When I finished the interview, I knew I had done my best," said Krick. "But I didn't think it had been good enough to win. I had convinced myself that I didn't win, and when I opened the envelope saying I had, I was hysterical."

Krick is the daughter of Susan and Edward Krick of Sandy. Her father accompanied her to Washington, D.C., for the award ceremony.

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Architect appointed to term on historic review board
