Under his leadership, the 30-person division was restructured to provide staff and services consistent with local market demands.

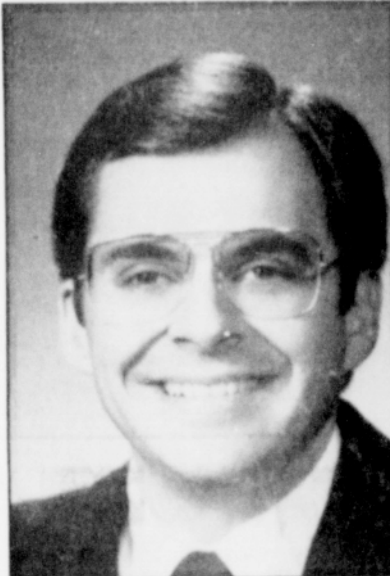
In his 16 years with the firm, Kennedy has managed a wide variety of waste water and solid waste management projects.

## Man hurt in three-car accident near Sandy

A three-car traffic accident Monday evening at the intersection of Southeast Kelso Road and Orient Drive hospitalized at least one person.

Eliseo Alcalá, 26, no address listed, was transported to the Mount Hood Medical Center in Gresham where he was listed in fair condition with inter-

nal injuries Tuesday.

Also injured were Luis G. Lopez, 27, of 855 S.E. Hogan Road and Rosendo Garcia, 16, no address listed. Both were transported to the medical center following the 6:45 p.m. accident. Both were treated and released.

The accident occurred when a four-

door Datsun driven by Ray E. Beam, 44, of Sandy pulled into the west-bound lane of Orient Drive and collided with a 1985 Willys pickup driven by Bud E. Golden, 21, of Sandy. Golden's vehicle then collided with a 1977 Ford pickup driven by Lopez.

No one in the first two vehicles was injured in the accident.



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
