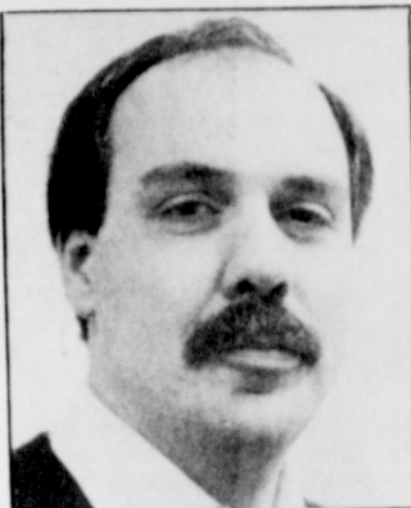
Architects meet at Timberline

The national meeting of the Historic Resources Committee of the American Institute of Architects will meet at Timberline Lodge this weekend.

Timberline Lodge was chosen for the meeting in part because of extensive historical preservation that has restored it to the condition it was in when Franklin Delano Roosevelt dedicated it 50 years ago.

The Friends of Timberline, with help from the Portland Junior League, spearheaded the rejuvenation of the interior, restoring, and repairing where necessary, the fine art, weaving, wood carving, ironworks and other crafts.

after 35 years as secretary to the superintendent in the Sandy Elementary District.

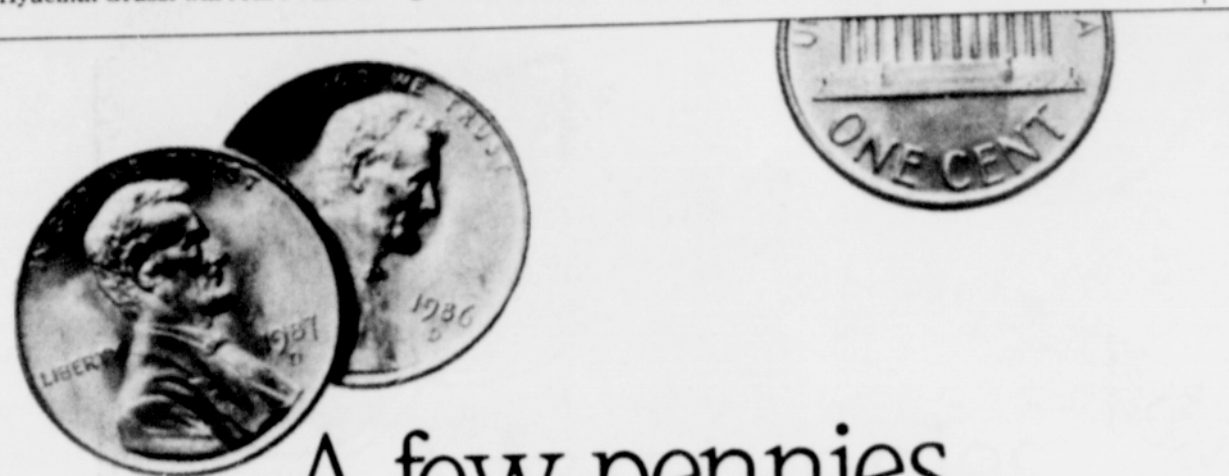
Grassl has worked for superintendents Harry Harvie, Clyde Sutherland, Tony Bryant, Clark Lund and Rex Hunsaker.
