

Airplane crashes

A small, single-engine airplane landed nose down in the grass in a field west of Sandy on Friday. The unidentified pilot told a nearby resident that he ran out of gas and had to crash-land the aircraft in the field, in the 32300 block of Southeast Dodge Park Boulevard. The landing occurred about 5:20 p.m. The pilot was reportedly uninjured in the incident and told the resident that he would be back the next day to retrieve the aircraft.

Goat study put on hold

A proposal to repopulate the Columbia River Gorge with mountain goats has been delayed temporarily so the idea can be coordinated with planning efforts for the national scenic area.

The forest service had planned to do an environmental impact study on the goats. Instead, that study will be coordinated with an overall study of the Columbia River Gorge National Scenic Area, said David Mohla, forest supervisor of the Mt. Hood National Forest.

The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife proposed in May to re-establish a "breeding population" of mountain goats for viewing and possibly hunting.

A few goats may be left in the gorge from an earlier effort to develop a population of the species. Between 1969 and 1975, 14 goats were released in the gorge.

A group of about 20 males, females and kids would be needed to begin a healthy population, said Jim Torland, a wildlife biologist with the state.

The U.S. Forest Service has asked for public input on the idea.

Man's condition still critical

Tony Jacobs of Corbett, the man who received burns to 81 percent of his body during a fiery car crash on Interstate 84 in mid-July, continued to be listed in critical condition Tuesday afternoon.

Meanwhile, employees and shoppers at Troutdale Thriftway have donated \$120 to a fund established to assist the Jacobs family.

Jacobs' wife, Pam, is employed at the Thriftway bakery. Store manager Gina White initiated the fund and is watching the donation cans and taking the money to a special account set up at the Gresham branch of Benjamin Franklin Federal Savings and Loan

Association. White said Monday that she is "pretty pleased" with donations so far and is hoping for more.

Jacobs, 28, received a second skin graft Friday at Emanuel Hospital and Medical Center's burn treatment unit.

Jacobs was transported to the medical center via Life Flight helicopter after being injured in a July 13 accident on I-84 near Northeast 47th Avenue in Portland. His car was hit from behind and burst into flames. Jacobs managed to crawl from the vehicle and other motorists smothered the flaming clothing.
