Halford Dudley

Halford A. Dudley, former postmaster at the Rhododendron post office and a Mount Hood farmer, died July 25 at a Gresham care center. He was 82.

Mr. Dudley was born in Rock Falls, Ill., on May 5, 1905. In 1920, he entered the U.S. Navy, where he served as both an enlisted man and a commissioned officer. He was married May 6, 1938, in Long Beach, Calif.

After retiring from the Navy as a first lieutenant in 1951, he and his wife moved to Oregon and farmed on a small farm on Mount Hood. He was postmaster of the Rhododendron post office from 1961 to 1974.

Mr. Dudley is survived by his wife, Orpha Dudley of Gresham; his children, Chris Johnson of San Diego, Calif., Polly Greenup of Darby, Mont., and Master Sgt. Halford Dudley of Frankfurt, Germany; his brother, Bill Dudley of Yuma, Ariz.; eight grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.

A memorial service was July 28 at Carroll Funeral Home. Private cremation preceded the service.

Funeral for Thomas E. Clark, a former resident of Gresham, was July 31.

Mr. Clark died at his home in Eagle Creek on July 28. He was 84.
