One sign that summer is coming to a close is the approach of another school year. Many area schools are currently enrolling students for the 1987-88 school year.

Sandy High School
Members of the freshman class will start school on Monday, Aug. 31, with sophomores, juniors and seniors starting the next day, Tuesday, Sept. 1.

Most students set up a schedule for 1987-88 during the spring of last school year. Registration was Aug. 17 and 18, but people who need to register late may call to make an appointment or may register the first day of school.

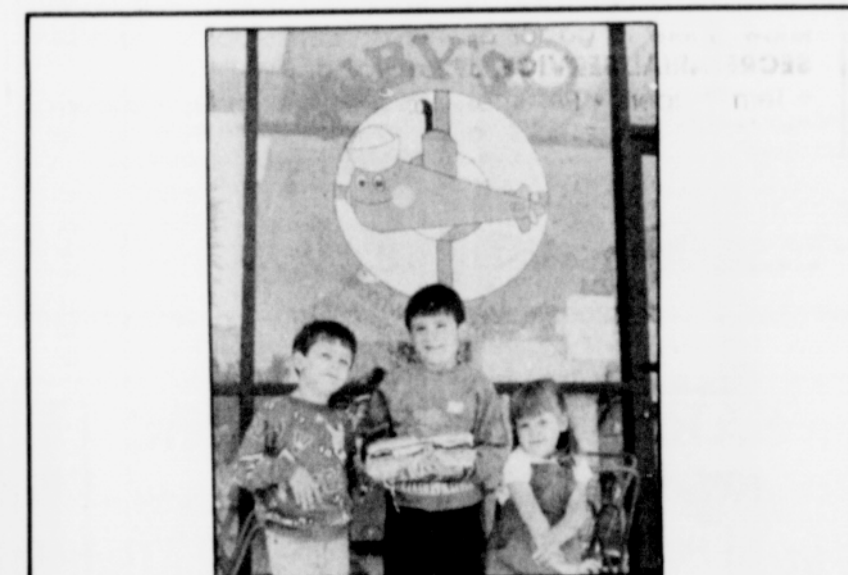
