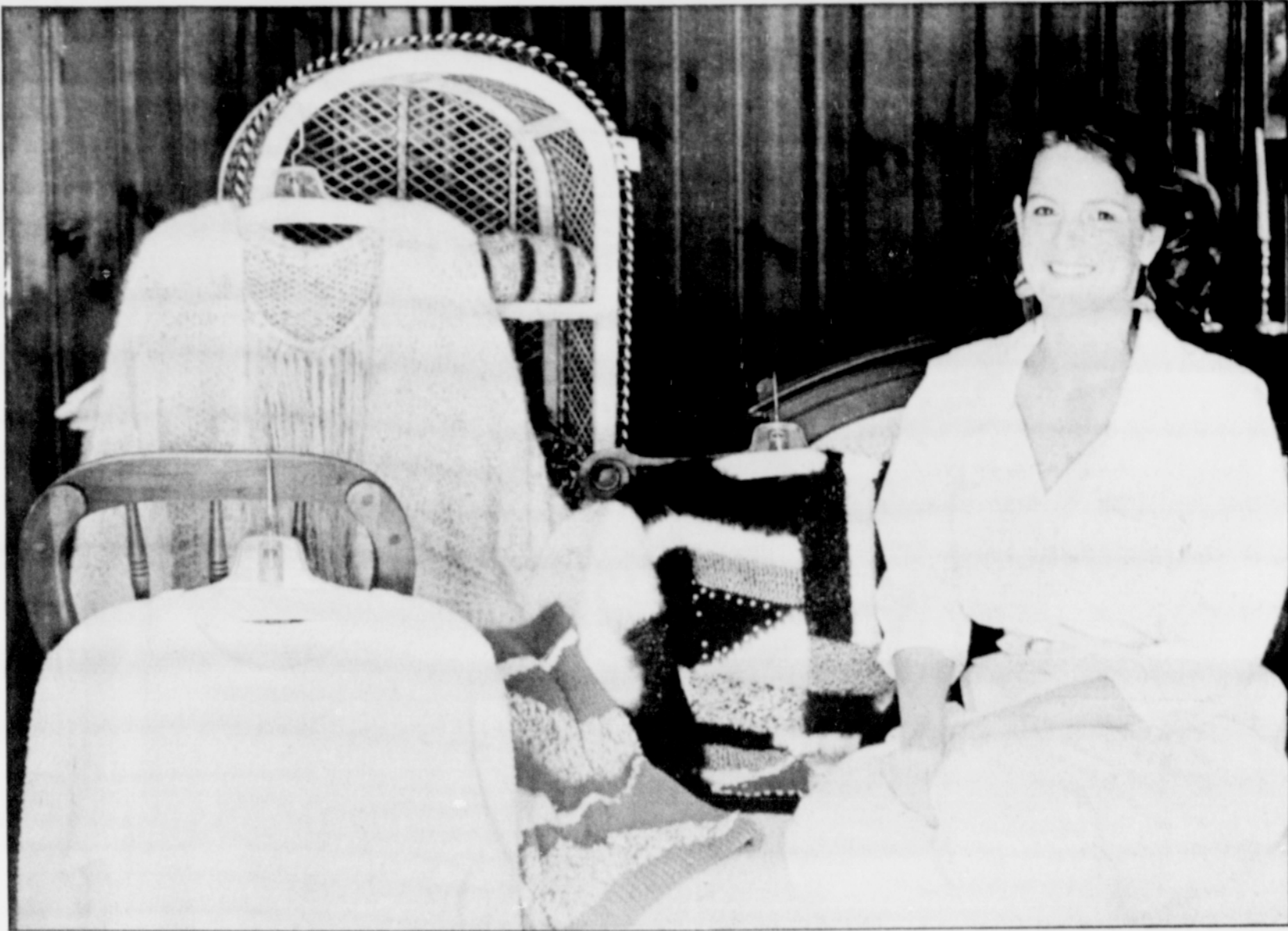

## Better Sweater offers classes

Colleen Benelli owned a yarn store with her mother and sister-in-law, but when she moved to Oregon she decided teaching, not retailing, was her strength.

At her business in La Costa, Calif., she taught knitting as a way to show customers how to use newly designed yarns and fabrics.

What she discovered was that she enjoyed teaching. She said she thinks she has a knack for it, along with an eye for design.

Benelli taught eight children this summer in her Kids Knit program, and has a full schedule of classes planned for adults and youngsters this fall.

Benelli, owner of The Better

Sweater, 39295 Scenic St., teaches all phases of knitting, from beginning to advanced.

Beginners will learn to stitch and read patterns.

More experienced knitters will learn charting and advanced finishing techniques. Charting is making a pattern from a picture or improvising in some other way. Finishing includes putting the sleeves on the body and weaving the ends.

"It really is an art form," Benelli said of knitting. "It brings out the creativity in people."

Benelli said she hopes to share her knowledge of new materials and yarns with advanced knitters.

In addition, she wants to help people design sweaters of their own.

That was one thing she enjoyed about working at the store she owned in California. "I got to play at designing sweaters all day."

Benelli has a number of sweaters on hand to show as samples of her work. Some individual sweaters feature a variety of stitches and a number of different materials, tied together by a theme or color scheme.

But even simple, wear-around-the-house sweaters can be sporty. Using quality material is one factor. "Even adding a button can make a difference," she said.

Benelli offers help in making

scarfs, mittens, hats, slippers and other knitted wear.

Day and evening classes are being offered this fall. Three Saturday seminars are planned. Seminar topics and the dates they will run include:

"How to Buy the Right Yarn," Oct. 17; "Sweater Design and Charting," Oct. 24; "Finishing! Unknitting! Fixing Mistakes!" Nov. 14.

The Kids Knit program will be offered again this fall by the Sandy Recreation Department.
