Club installs new president

Darrell Dempster, a Sandy realtor, was installed recently as president of the Kiwanis Club of Sandy. Dempster is also known for his leadership on the Sandy Mountain Festival committee.

He assumed the duties of club president on Oct. 1. He previously served in that capacity during the 1981-82 club year.

Ned Dyal, a certified public accountant in Sandy, has just completed his second term as club president. Dyal was also president the 1970-71 year.

Sam Won, newly installed lieutenant governor of Division 66, Northwest District of Kiwanis International, officiated as installation officer.

Won is a member of the Milwaukie Kiwanis Club.

Social security cards available

Sandy-area parents are urged to apply for their children's Social Security cards. A new IRS regulation requires every child older than age 4 to have a Social Security number.

If an exemption is claimed for a dependent child on a parent's 1987 income tax return, and no Social Security number is listed for the child, the IRS will disallow the exemption. In 1987 the exemption will be worth \$1,900.

Arthur Lobingier, manager of the East Portland Social Security office, said that since February the school system has cooperated with his office to inform parents of the new requirement.

Until recently, the response has been less than anticipated.

"In the past few weeks there has been an upsurge in activity and now there is a backlog of applications. The time required to receive a card from our Baltimore headquarters

has doubled to six weeks," Lobingier said.

If the trend continues, by the end of October the delay may be up to two months and those who postpone applying until the end of the year may not receive a card by April 15.

Proof of age and identity must accompany an application. Acceptable evidence is a birth certificate plus a school report card, student body card, a recent doctor's bill showing the child's name or some other document that refers to the child.

All papers submitted must be original documents or copies certified by the official custodian. Commercial photocopies are not acceptable. Applications and required papers can be mailed or presented to the Social Security office at 12630 Division St., Portland, 97236.

Employees will record the evidence and return the documents promptly, Lobingier said.

SUHS seniors are honored

have been designated as commended students in the 1988 National Merit Scholarship Program and will receive a letter of commendation.

Martin and Ten Eyck were among the top 50,000 seniors of the more than one million participants in the 33rd annual Merit Program.

Participants entered the Merit Program by taking the PSAT/NMS-QT in October 1986, when most of them were juniors.

Although their qualifying test scores are high, the 35,000 young people throughout the nation who are commended students scored slightly below the level required for semifinalist standing.

Only 15,000 semifinalist will continue in the competition for some 6,000 Merit Scholarships to be awarded in the spring of 1988.
