World premiere at Timberline

A world premiere of the suite "Up at Timberline" will be held on Sunday, Oct. 11, at 2 p.m. in the main lobby of Timberline Lodge.

The suite, composed by Jacob Avshalomov and performed by the Portland Youth Philharmonic, celebrates Timberline's 50th anniversary.

It consists of three movements: "The Mountain," with primordial sounds and pre-human stirrings; "The Lodge," with implications of Indian Lodges — ceremonial drums and incantations; and "The Action," suggesting the social activity following exhilarations on the slopes, nostalgic phrases and cavorting dance-tunes from the '30s.

The ensemble consists of two groups of eight players. Winds and light percussion will perform on the mezzanine, brass and heavier percussion at the fireplace level.

The title itself implies an "up" mood as well as the experience of being "Up at Timberline."

Music by Monteverdi, Mozart and Joplin will complete the afternoon program.

Avshalomov, conductor of the Portland Youth Philharmonic since 1954, previously played in the orchestra while a student at Reed College.

He has composed more than 40 works for the orchestra, chorus, voice and chamber groups.

Born in China and trained at the Eastman School of Music, he served on the Columbia University music faculty for eight years.

Sculptor presents bronze piece

Fran Taylor, auxiliary member and past president, is chairwoman of the cancer aid and research committee.

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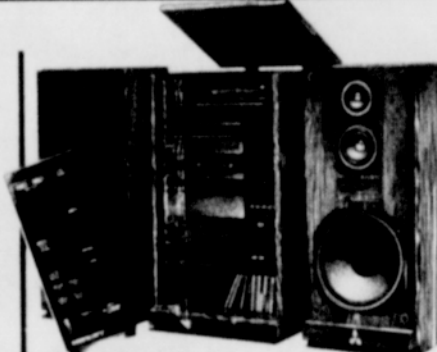
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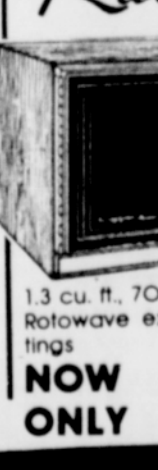
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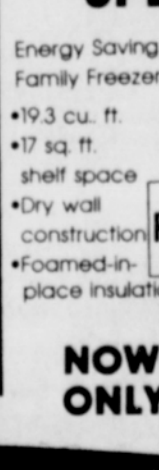


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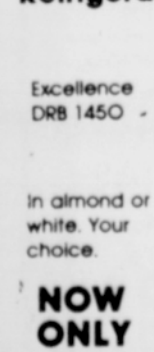
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
