Church building remodeled

Members of the Spirit and Truth Fellowship are building a church in Sandy in more ways than one.

The group, which held services in Boring for a year and a half, has from 12 to 18 members and plans to grow further in numbers by moving to Sandy.

Members of the congregation are also literally building a church, as in driving nails, pouring concrete and applying paint.

They have been working on the church at 38500 Pioneer Blvd. since June, and hope to be done by the end of November, although Pastor John Huessy is flexible about the deadline.

The effort is being aided by the contributions of a carpenter, a painter and a former cement finisher, who are members of the congregation. But the lack of numbers hinders progress on the remodeling. The building, which was the site of a Baptist church 40 years ago in recent times has been used as a personal residence. During periods of vacancy, the building has suffered some vandalism.

Huessy does not seem flustered

by the seemingly endless list of things to do. He said he thinks it will be nice when the building is completed.

"It's always nice to have a place you can call your own. When people think of a church, they expect a building."

This isn't the first time Huessy has built a church. A journeyman

cabinet maker, he has been involved in the remodeling of three other churches.

Huessy has been a member of the Pentecostal church for 14 years. He has been licensed as a pastor in the church for five years. For the past year, congregation

members have been meeting at the home of Huessy and his wife, Elaine, and their three children. The church they were renting in Boring was reclaimed by the Methodist church.

Huessy said the Spirit and Truth Fellowship congregation is affiliated with the United Pentecostal Church. Members believe in a literal interpretation of the scriptures.

They offer a 13-lesson home Bible study, called "Exploring God's Word," which starts with the Book of Genesis in the Old Testament and goes all the way through to the Book of Revelation in the New Testament.

Huessy said he offers the program to people without pressuring them to go to church.

"I want people to pick up the Bible and read the word of God for themselves."

"I really feel that is the answer, for people to get the Bible in their hands."

Church services are held at 11:30 a.m. on Sundays at 39360 Barker Court. Sunday school starts at 9:45. There is also a Bible study on Thursdays at 7:30 p.m. in the conference room of the U.S. National Bank, 38561 Proctor Blvd. For more information, call Huessy at 668-7758.

Which church is the oldest?

Which church in Sandy is the oldest?

According to "Sandy Pioneers, Early Settlers and Barlow Road Days," a history of Sandy compiled by the Sandy Pioneer and Historical Association, St. Michael's Catholic Church and Immanuel Lutheran Church are the oldest churches in town.

St. Michael's opened its doors on Dec. 18, 1894, at which time 40 families belonged to the church.

The original church building was destroyed by fire in 1917.

Immanuel Lutheran Church first held services on Aug. 18, 1901.

According to the pioneer book, A.E. Kern, an agent for medicines and fire insurance, desired to see a Lutheran church in Sandy. He was told that when 11 men signed a request for services, the district would send them a pastor.

"Despite the fact that three of the signers turned out to be avowed atheists and some others had no real religious interest, a small group continued to hold regular services in the Sandy Hotel, the Sandy Ridge School or Junker's dance hall," the Pioneer Association book says.

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
