Part of the update includes the creation of a Working Group to make recommendations to EWEB's Board of Commissioners. EWEB is accepting applications through Oct. 17, 2003, from customers who are interested in serving on the Working Group.

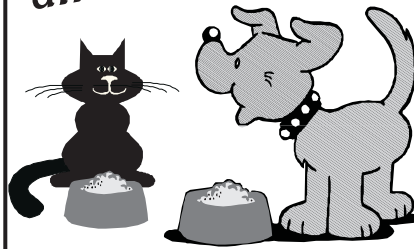
The Working Group will meet approximately once per month between January and June 2004.
