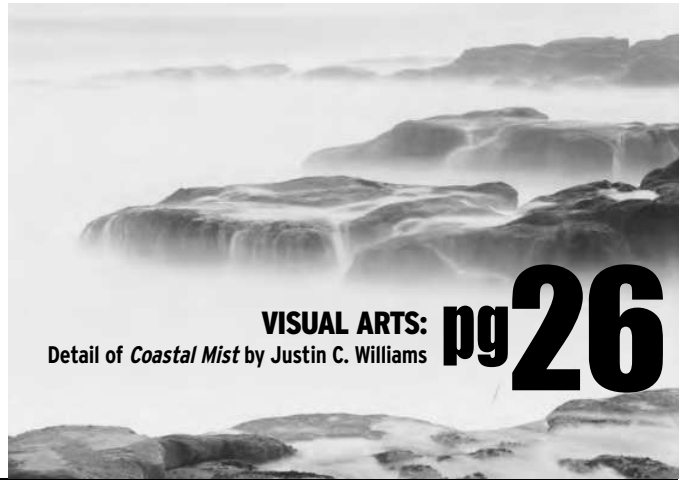

Public invited to apply for riverfront master plan Community Advisory Team

Application deadline: March 28, 2008

The Eugene Water & Electric Board is seeking the public's help in creating a new vision for the utility's property along the Willamette River. A Community Advisory Team will be formed to develop a draft master plan for the riverfront property.

Any Eugene citizen or EWEB customer can apply for one of nine positions on the advisory team. EWEB Commissioners will consider the recommendations of the advisory team, prior to adopting a Riverfront Master Plan that is forwarded to the City of Eugene for approval.

Successful applicants must be willing to meet two or three times per month for more than a year, beginning in April 2008. Application packets are available on EWEB's web site, www.eweb.org, in the atrium at EWEB, at the City Manager's office, or at the Eugene Permit and Information Center (99 W. 10th Ave.).
