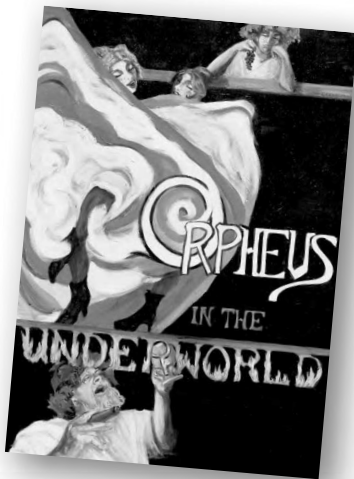
ORPHEUS IN THE UNDERWORLD

Star of Wonder A Christmas Miracle

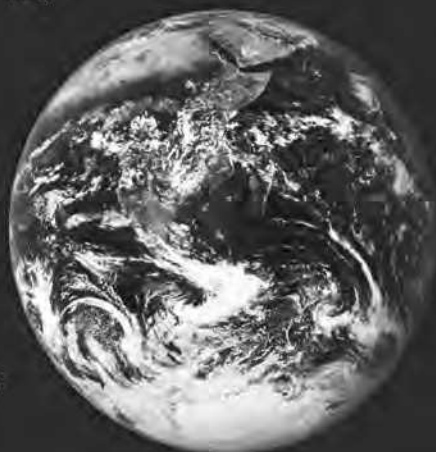
