BETTER THAN EZRA - PAPER EMPIRE: - Full of the great hooks and melodies that the band is famous for, Paper Empire marks yet another step forward in main BTE songwriter Kevin Griffin's evolution as a master tunesmith and builds on the great work Kevin has done writing with and for artists like Howie Day, David Cook, Train and Missy Higgins.



BLIND PILOT - 3 ROUNDS & A SOUND: Willamette Week proclaimed: "Every once in a while a band comes along that knocks me so flat on my ass that I wish I was in the PR business or an A&R guy instead of a critic, so I could throw myself wholeheartedly behind it. Blind Pilot [gave] me that sensation."



AIDEN - KNIVES: 2009 album from the Seattle-based Post-Hardcore rockers. Knives is guaranteed to be the album that will close this decade off with style and open the floodgates to a whole new chapter for dark defiant Rock. Knives is an absolute adrenalin rush that leaves the listener completely winded and wanting more.



TORI AMOS - ABNORMALLY ATTRACTED TO SIN: Tori's tenth studio album, is another innovative chapter in the artist's trailblazing story. Every track on the album will be accompanied by a corresponding 'visualette,' featuring footage that has been captured over the past year. Shot in HD and Super 8, the visualettes will incorporate a documentary style.



DANE COOK - ISOLATED INCIDENT: Dane reinvented his act and took it to the stage in front of 400 people at the Laugh Factory in Hollywood. Here, he showcases a darker and more personal set with cutting edge material that pushes the envelope. The double-digipak contains a CD of his best new material plus a DVD documenting the making of the album.



SAMANTHA CRAIN - SONGS IN THE NIGHT : Her voice is gorgeously odd, all fulsome, shape-shifting vowels that do indeed billow like fog. But while her moody country rock is full of dark themes, she rarely gives in to them. Her band plays with jaunty sweetness, shuffling and bouncing through sorghum-sticky melodies.



STEVE EARLE - TOWNES: The 15-song set is comprised of songs written by Earle's friend and mentor, the late singer-songwriter, Townes Van Zandt. The album was produced by Earle at his home in Greenwich Village, at Sound Emporium and Room and Board in Nashville, TN and The Nest in Hollywood, CA.



EMINEM - RELAPSE: Highly anticipated 2009 album from one of the most successful Rap artists in history. Now, 10 years after The Slim Shady LP, Eminem marks his 10th anniversary as a Hip Hop hurricane with Relapse, yet another skillful collaboration with Dr. Dre. Features the single 'Crack A Bottle'.



FLATLANDERS - HILLS AND VALLEYS: The legendary Flatlanders -- Jimmie Dale Gilmore, Joe Ely and Butch Hancock -- three of Texas most respected singer/songwriters, return with their new album Hills And Valleys. It could be the best song any of them have ever had a hand in writing.



GREEN DAY - 21ST CENTURY BREAKDOWN: The album is the best-selling trio's first studio album since 2004's two-time Grammy Award-winning Punk Rock opera American Idiot. 21st Century Breakdown is divided into 3 acts: 'Heroes and Cons,' 'Charlatans and Saints,' and 'Horseshoes and Handgrenades,' and follows a young couple through the mess & promise of the century so far.



DEL MCCOURY - BY REQUEST: For 50 years, Del's music defined authenticity for hard core Bluegrass fans as well as a growing number of fans among those only vaguely familiar with the genre. And while By Request provides an opportunity to look back on a unique legacy, it's also some of the best music he's ever made.



OTHER LIVES - SELFTITLED: With an organic, orchestrated sound that incorporates elements of Progressive Rock, Folk and classical music, Other Lives draws its inspiration from a similarly wide array of sources: from historical events to the landscape in which the members grew up. Recorded with producer Joey Waronker (Beck, the Eels, Lisa Germano) and engineer Darrell Thorp (Radiohead, Outkast, Beck).
