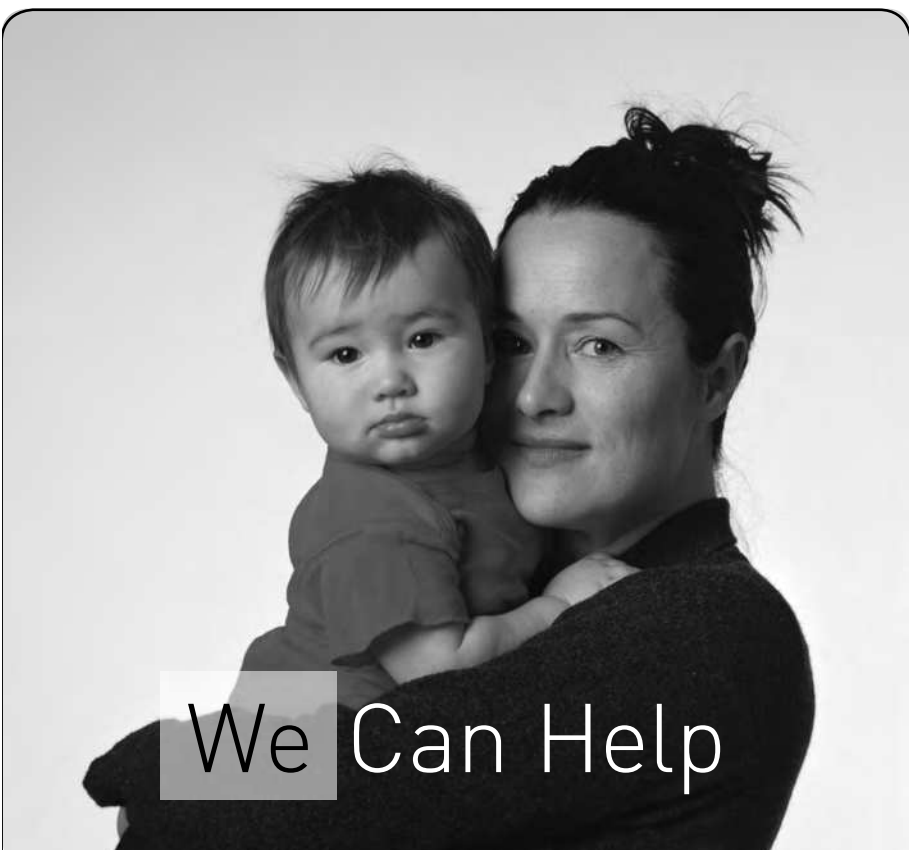

Do you own or rent a home that is electrically heated?
We can help weatherize it.

EWEB will pay the full cost for adding insulation to eligible homes—and 35-50% of the cost of new windows. Additional weatherization funding is now available from the Eugene Water & Electric Board for installing insulation and other energy-saving improvements in homes of income-qualifying customers. Now you can increase your comfort in winter and summer while lowering your energy bills.

You're eligible for these rebates if you're an EWEB electric customer who rents or owns a home that is electrically heated, the home was built before 1981, and your combined household income is no more than \$26,971 for a single occupant, no more than \$35,268 for a household of two, or no more than \$43,567 for a household of three.
