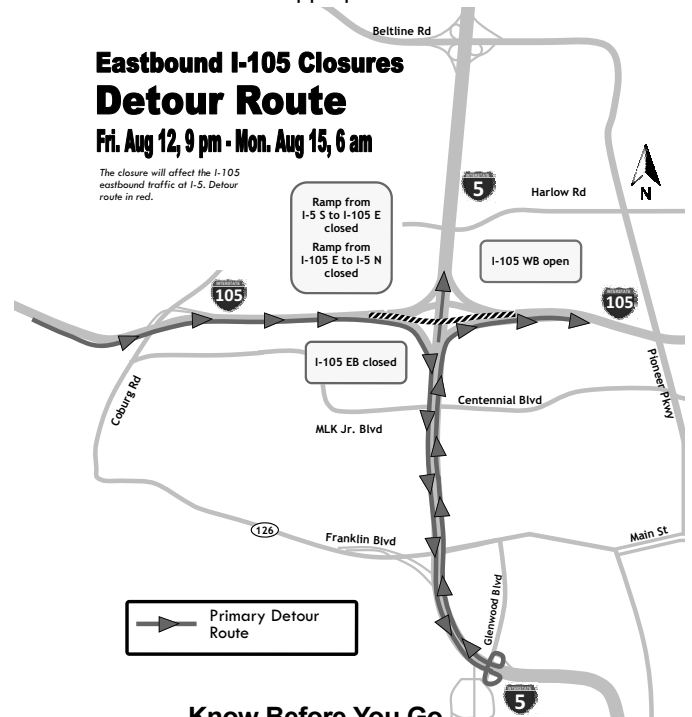
The following I-5 connecting ramps will also be closed:

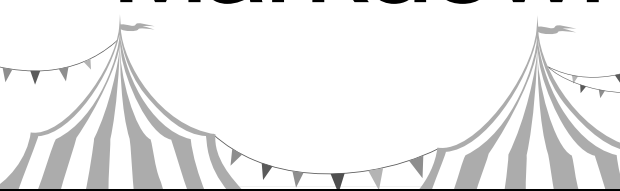
