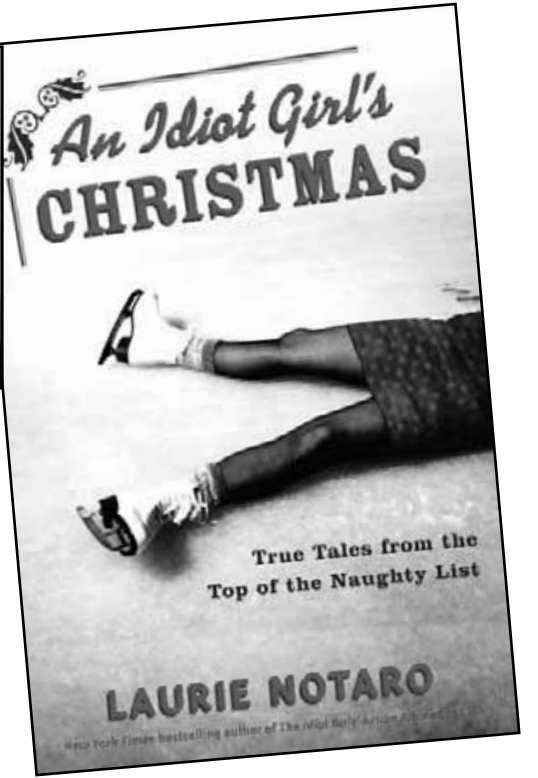

Raw log exports to China are at an all-time high. Meanwhile, logging corporations pay almost nothing in taxes while Oregon's trees and our jobs are shipped overseas. **Logging corporations need to pay their fair share.** Yet Rep. Peter DeFazio is promoting the idea of re-linking funding for rural counties to clear-cutting of Oregon's public forest lands, rather than finding solutions that make logging corporations pay their fair share.
