Local youth read, interpret and respond to Dr. King's writings on Human Rights. Through poetry, music, and spoken word, youth express their views.

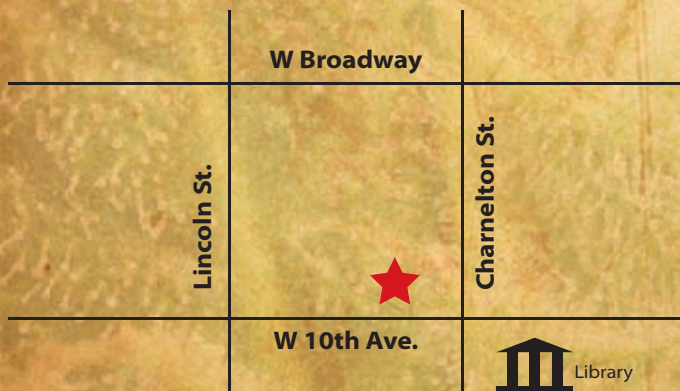
