a chocolate cookie crust with layers of chocolate custard, strawberry white chocolate mousse, and vanilla whipped cream

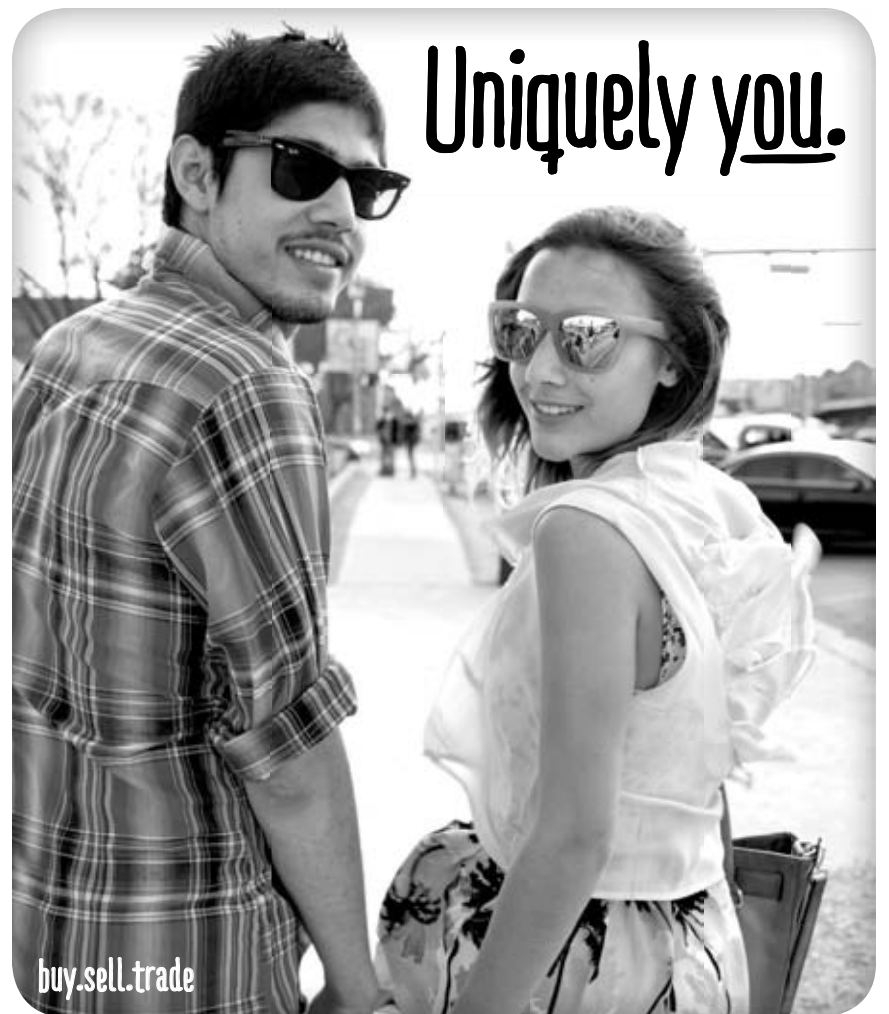


Blueberry Lemon Custard Pie
